




Because of man's wickedness, God




Only one man believed and served God. He and his family were spared.

God chose a nation of people to serve Him (the Israelites) and He gave them laws to live by. (Genesis 17:1-9; Exodus 20:1-17)




Twelve tribes of Israel

But they rebelled and killed the prophets. (Matthew 23:29-33)




But they continually failed and turned away from the Lord. (Jeremiah 7:23-24)

Jesus, the Creator, fulfilled over 30 prophecies when He allowed Himself to be murdered by man. (John 18-21)





But Satan was defeated because three days later, Jesus rose from the dead. (Luke 24 1-7)




If the powers of darkness had known this would happen, they never would have crucified the Lord. (1 Connthians 2.8)

They will be judged guilty by the Lord Jesus Christ, Himself.


