
He was to be Israel's saviour. Both Moses and his brother,

Aaron, were sent to Egypt,





"And the fish that was in the river died; and the river stank, and the Egyptians could not drink of the water of the river, and there was blood throughout all the land of Egypt."



up in stinking heaps. But Pharoah refused to let Israel go. Exodus 8:14




This is the finger of God!












## Preparation for the Passover... The final Plague

The Lord told Israel to borrow jewels of silver and gold from the rineighbors




And the Lord gave them favor with the Egyptians —The Egyptians considered Moses a very great man.


