


**SUNDAY

'Cuz he's drunk! He's always drunk!




I'm sorry, Janice ... we'd better get to the hospital and see how your mother is.

At east we tried!




MMMMMMMM

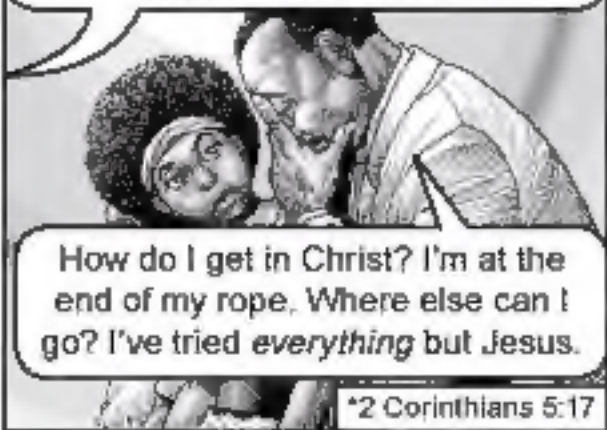
