


No wonder he's speaking at the




And a limo will pick you up at 5 a.m. tomorrow for your TV interview.



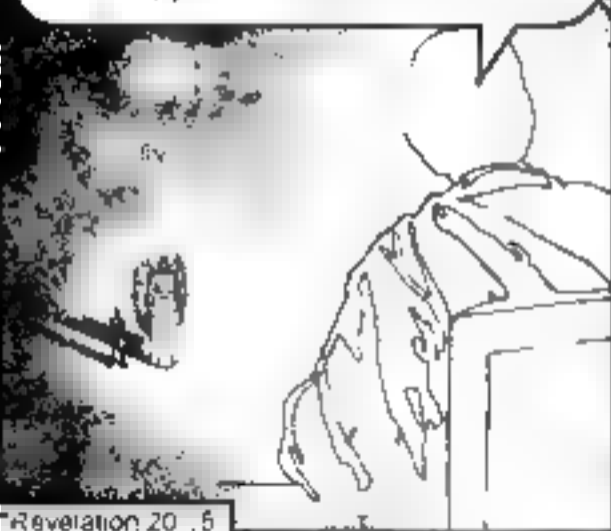
