Have a wonderful trip!


We will.

That old fanatic's upset me for the last time!


I'm about to meet some of the most important people I'll ever meet in my life...

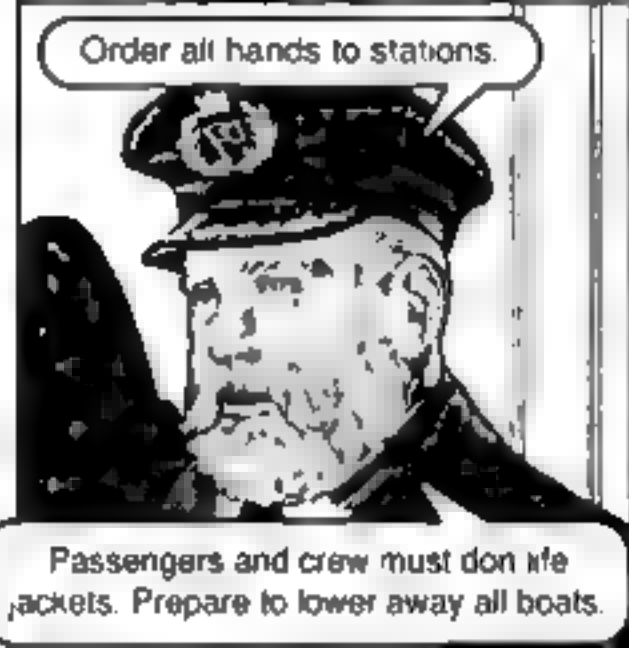


Sir, we're taking water in


