Her very life depends...

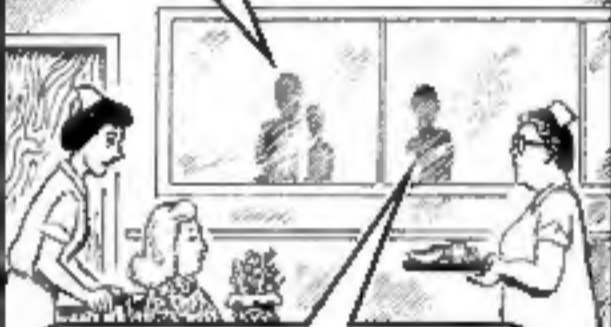
Stop it, Donna, I'm *sure*

Yes, we are Jehovah's Witnesses.




Oh, really? I've studied the beliefs of the Watchtower Society."

If he can't convince them in the next 30 minutes, we're going to have a little corpse on our hands.



Such as?


I believe in the deity of Christ.

I believe there are verses in the Bible that show Jesus is God Almighty. Can we look at them?


Sure.

"I, even I, am the Lord;* and beside me there is no saviour."* (Isa. 43:11)

*New World Translation (Watchtower version) substitutes "Jehovah" for "Lord."

Speaking of Jesus in Acts 4:12, it says:


I have a question about your **New World Translation** of the scriptures, Doug



That's true




In 1920, the Society predicted* the physical return of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and the faithful prophets of old for 1925.
