Daniel reminded the king of how everybody had feared his father, King Nebuchadnezzar.




But when Nebuchadnezzar grew proud, God let him go mad for 7 years until he repented. (Daniel 4:30-33.)

But as he spoke, two armies were

That same night, Belshazzar was killed.

Everyone, including King Darius, trusted Daniel. He was a true and honest servant of God.

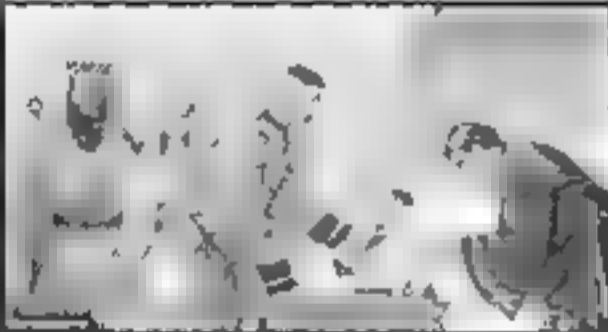
King Darius set up 120 princes over the kingdom, and over these men, three presidents...



See Daniel 6.

... of whom Daniel was first.

Daniel was a blessing to everybody. The Spirit of God prospered everything he did.



Nobody had wisdom and understanding like Daniel. King Darius put him over everyone in the kingdom.

The jealous princes turned green with envy. Daniel wasn't of royal blood.




He was only a Jewish slave who long ago rose to power under King Nebuchadnezzar. And they wanted him **DEAD, DEAD, DEAD!**

The police launched an investigation of Daniel.

Get any dirt you can on this old Jew!  
Sex problems? Bribes?


Don't rest until you find **SOMETHING**  
that we can use to hang him!

Is he corrupt? Did he rise  
to power using witchcraft?



After all this time, we've got absolutely nothing on Daniel! He doesn't even have any faults!

The only thing he does in excess is pray. He prays *three times daily* to his God.

But Daniel feared and loved God more than his life so he made his decision. He prayed anyway

Who was it?

Daniel. O King! He is still praying to his God so he must face the lions

The king was furious. He had been tricked into destroying Daniel, his best friend.

All day long, the king tried to change the law
