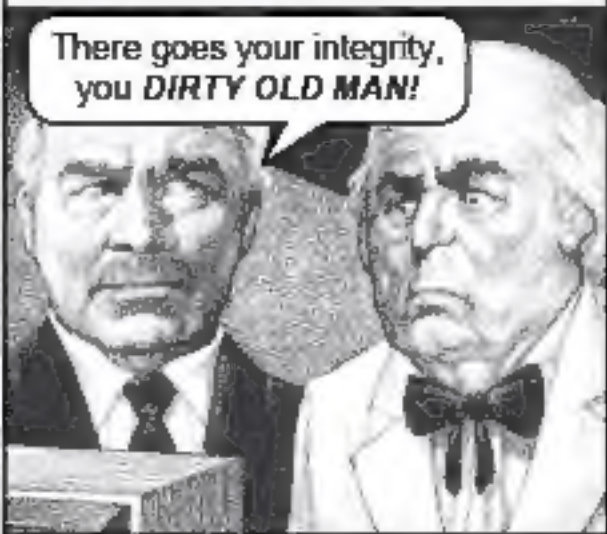
I have a secret video

you **DIRTY OLD MAN!**



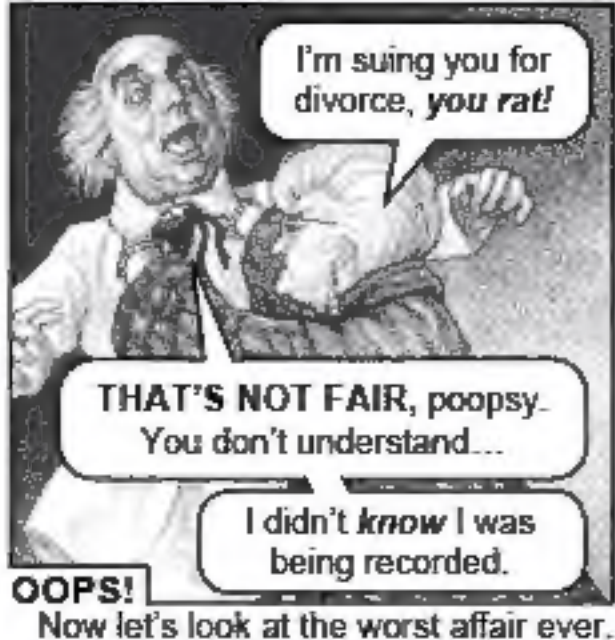
I'm suing you for

That same night, David's close walk with the Lord ended.


**Gasp!**

That didn't work either so David  
resorted to cold-blooded murder



Uriah, give this letter  
to your general

Uriah never dreamed the letter  
contained his death sentence.

Unah was to be sent into the hottest part of the battle and left alone to die



Unah's commander instantly knew that David wanted Unah *dead!*

David murdered this faithful soldier, breaking another commandment...



"Thou shalt not kill." Exodus 20:13

David thought he had gotten away with it, so he married Bathsheba before the baby came



“But the thing that David had done displeased the Lord.” 2 Samuel 11:27

When the child was born, God sent His prophet, Nathan



To blow this scandal *WIDE OPEN!*

**Nathan told David this story, knowing that David was once a good shepherd.**

A rich man had many sheep, while a poor man and his children had just one little lamb, whom they all loved.



When the rich man wanted to feed a guest, rather than killing one of his own sheep, he butchered Fluffy.

As the Lord liveth, the man that hath done this thing shall surely die because he had no pity.\*

Then Nathan dropped the bomb:


**THOU** art the man!

You killed him with the sword.

so the sword will never leave your house.

David was cut to the heart. He knew this was the Word of God



"I have sinned against the Lord."

David begged God to forgive him, so the Lord did.



But because David had given  
God's enemies great opportunity  
to curse the Lord, Nathan said

"the child also that is born unto  
thee shall surely die"

After 7 days God took the baby home

"I shall go to  
him (in heaven),  
but he shall not  
return to me"<sup>12</sup>

<sup>12</sup> Samuel 12:23

Did you get that?  
The baby went **TO HEAVEN!**

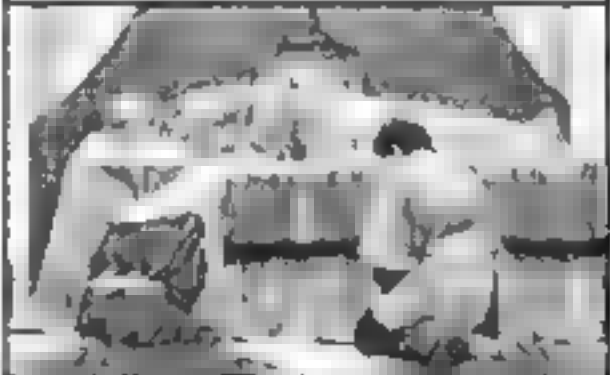
Do *ALL* babies who die go to heaven?

***Absolutely!***

Every single baby who has ever died is *now* in heaven, whether they died in the womb or by any type of tragedy: sickness, plague, human sacrifice, starvation *or even abortion!*

This truth comforted David, but his son's death was only part of the price he and his family would pay for his sin.

By the time David died, his family had gone through a literal hell, facing murder, rape and incest.



David and his family paid a horrible price for that one "Royal Affair."<sup>2</sup>

God has always hated adultery  
In the Old Testament, the penalty  
for this crime was death.\*



\*Lev 20:10

Today, millions of families are  
destroyed because the world  
makes a big joke out of adultery.

They call it "an affair,"  
but God STILL HATES IT!

whoremongers and *adulterers*  
God will judge" Hebrews 13:4

God says, "Be not deceived: neither  
fornicators nor *adulterers* .. shall  
inherit the kingdom of God."

Also see Matt 5:32

1 Cor 5:9-10

Millions will be shocked after death.

You have an appointment with God.

\*See Matt. 12:36

Your whole life will be played back.\*

EVERY act of adultery will be revealed.

No one will ever know.

Oh, no!  
That's **ME!**

But in His love, God made one way for adulterers or adulteresses to be forgiven before that terrible day.

Jesus Christ left heaven to die on the cross... *for you!*

"For God so loved the world (you), that he gave his only begotten Son (Jesus), that whosoever believeth in him should not perish (in hell), but have everlasting life (in heaven)." John 3:16
