


## THE OUTSIDER



Life in Moab had been cruel to Naomi. Everything was gone. The famine's over. I'm going home. Return to your mother's house.


She blessed them and kissed them and they all wept.


Orpah returned to her home and her old gods... a bad mistakel

When barley was harvested, the kernals that fell to the ground were to be left for the poor.






Ruth went into a field owned by Boaz.

Ruth was amazed that such a great man even spoke to her






As Ruth carried the glearings home all she could think of was Boaz




God was playing the matchmaker

Ruth and Naomi were overloyed They were saved from a life of misery and possible starvation.




They were married and Ruth, once an outsider, became the weelthiest and most respected women in Bethlehem.
