I wish Joseph was dead!

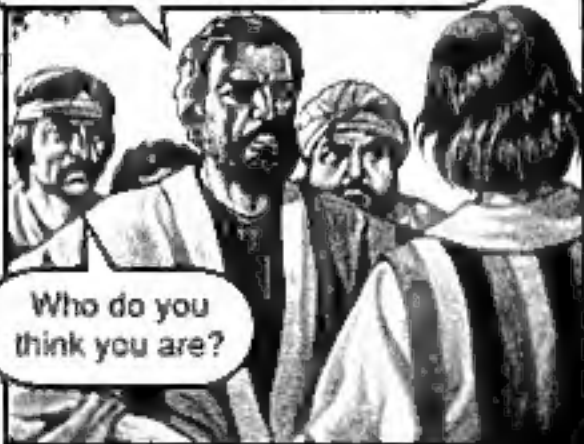
Me too!

His brothers were deadly, vicious men.

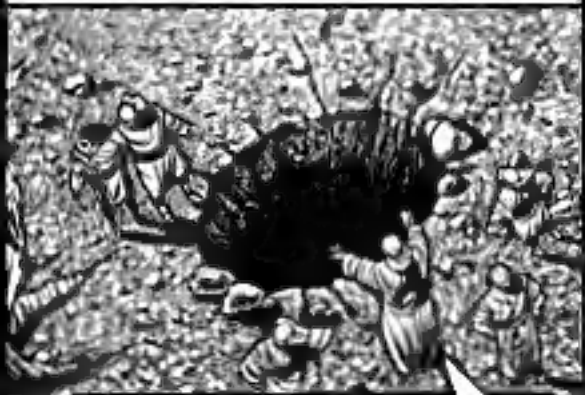
The dreamer's coming.

This will end his crazy dreams.



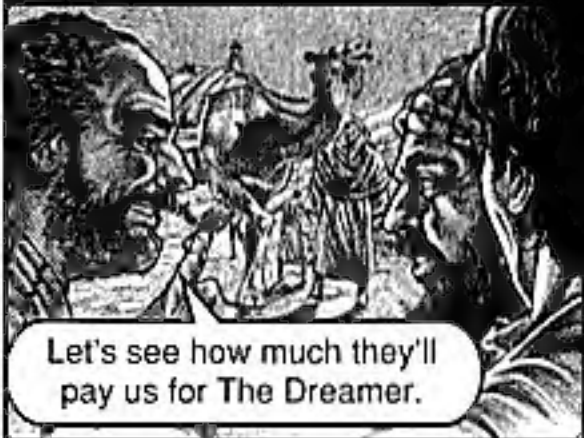
The pit was dry and sandy.

won't sin against God.

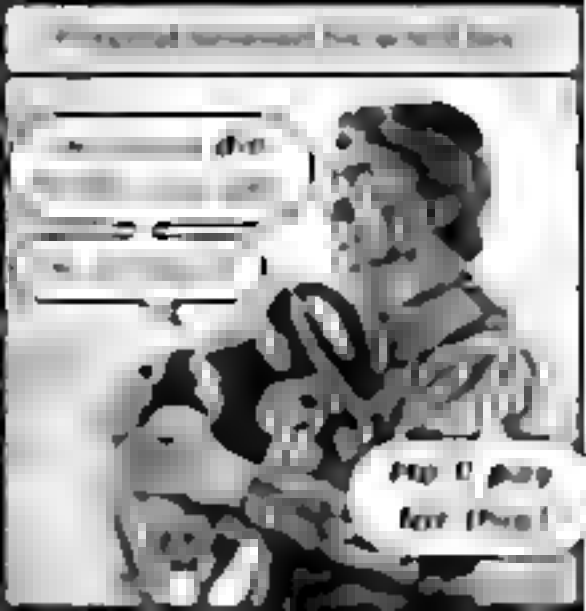
She acted innocent when servants

filled the granaries to overflowing



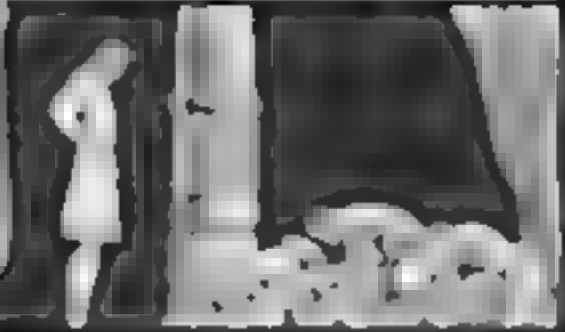

Fear not. What you did to me was evil, but God turned it to good.




Joseph sent them to bring their families to Egypt so he could protect them.
