As Moses grew up, he hated how the Egyptians treated the Jews.



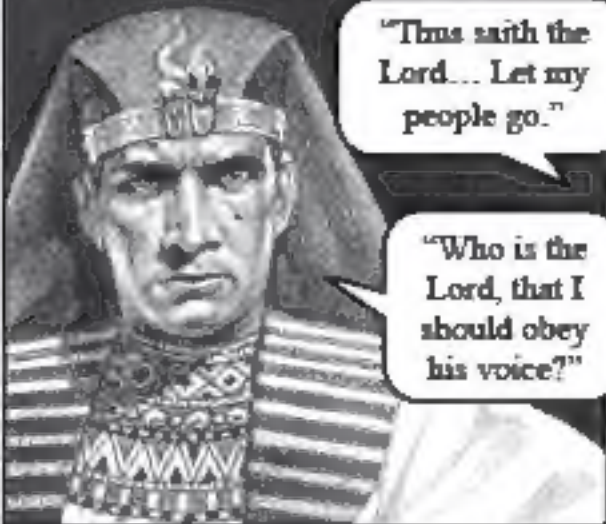
One day he killed an Egyptian for hurting a slave.

**Plague
#1 hit!**

When Moses plunged his rod into the Nile River (one of Egypt's main gods), all the water in Egypt turned into blood.



“And the fish that was in the river died; and the river stank, and the Egyptians could not drink of the water of the river; and there was blood throughout all the land of Egypt.” ***The Egyptians were terrified!***

The 2nd Plague

They worshiped frogs, so God covered the land with them.



They even got in bed with Pharaoh.

Pharaoh promised to let Israel go if Moses got rid of the frogs.



Dead frogs were piled in heaps, and the land stunk. But Pharaoh refused to keep his word.

The 3rd Plague

Because they worshiped lice, God turned the dust into lice.

Pharaoh's magicians turned water into blood and made frogs appear. But they **couldn't** bring forth lice.



"This is the finger of God."



But Pharaoh dug in his heels again.

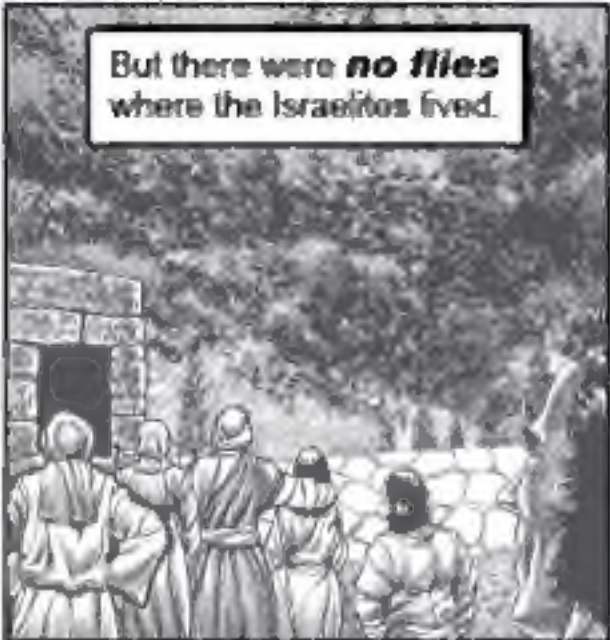
The 4th Plague

silver and gold from the Egyptians



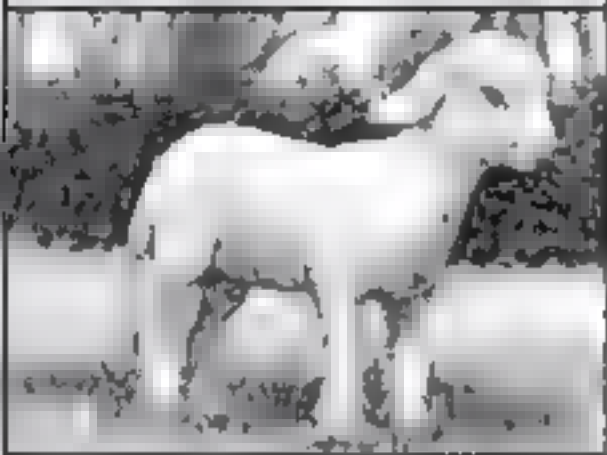
In fear, the Egyptians gave away
all their wealth.

The last plague would destroy
Egypt... and deliver Israel.

“For I will pass through the
land of Egypt this night,
and will smite (kill) all
the firstborn in the land of
Egypt, both man and beast,
and against *all* the gods
of Egypt I will execute
judgment. I am the Lord.”

Exodus 12:12

But God told Israel how to protect themselves from this last plague



Every home was to kill an unblemished lamb. It would be the "passover lamb."

The blood of the lamb was put in a basin. The life of their firstborn depended on strict obedience.



Then came the most important step.

The blood was to be put on each door post to protect that home



“ when I (Jesus) see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you ”

Pharaoh **finally** gave up!

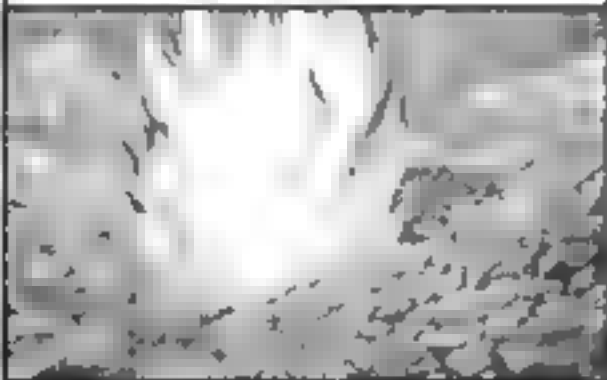
After 400 years, Israel was free,

deliverance

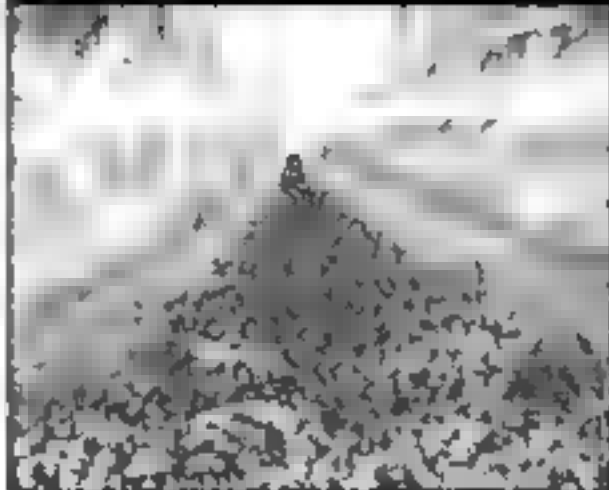
*Genesis 15: 13-14
