

Wherefore as by one man (Adam) sin entered into the world, and death by sin and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned. Romans 5:12

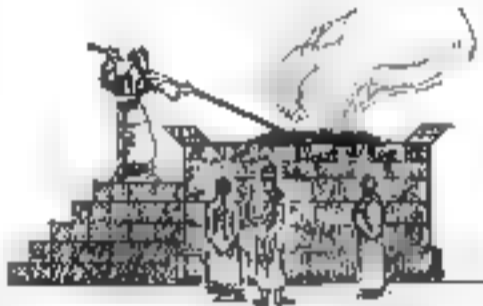
That sin was passed down to everyone who's ever lived. And it separates us from God



That's why we **ALL** deserve hell

For the wages of sin is death. Rom 6:23

To get sins forgiven, God has *always* required that innocent blood be shed (Hebrews 9:22)




In Old Testament times, God's people sacrificed animals to temporarily cover their sins. But the blood of the animals could not *remove sin's stain*.

Then, 2,000 years ago, God sent His Son to earth to shed His precious blood to deal with the sin problem

"Christ was *once* offered to bear the sins of many" Hebrews 9:28



What's so special about Jesus' blood?

I will **GOD'S** BLOOD



cross, I will be **ONE** with God's blood


Winthrop, the greatest day in history was the day that Jesus Christ shed His blood so our sins could be washed away.
