And God said "Let there be light."

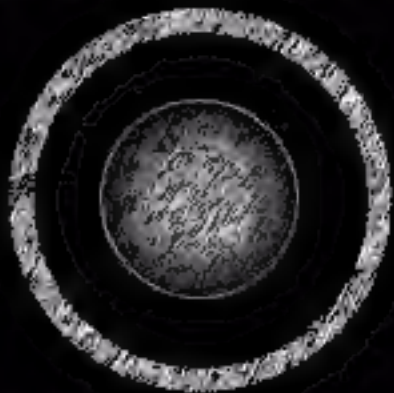
On Day One, "God divided the light from the darkness. He called the light Day and the darkness Night!"

Haw Haw, I gotcha!**

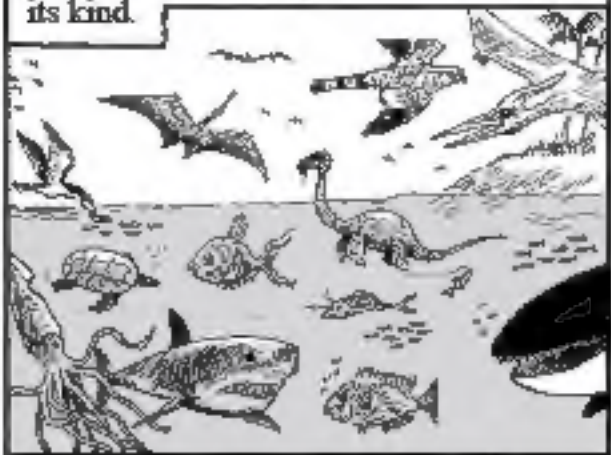
Gen. 1:9-13

Day 5: The waters brought forth fish in abundance and every winged fowl after its kind.



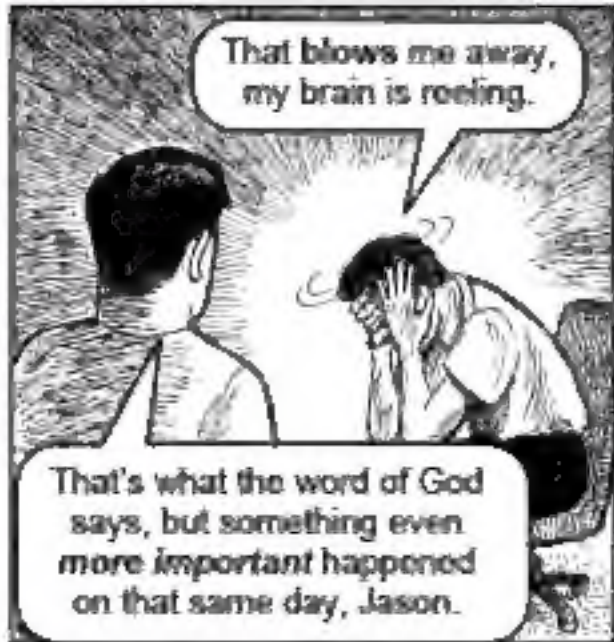
Now!... Are you ready for the Apatosaurus and Tyrannosaurus Rex?

cattle and creeping things and beasts of the earth after his kind and it was so."

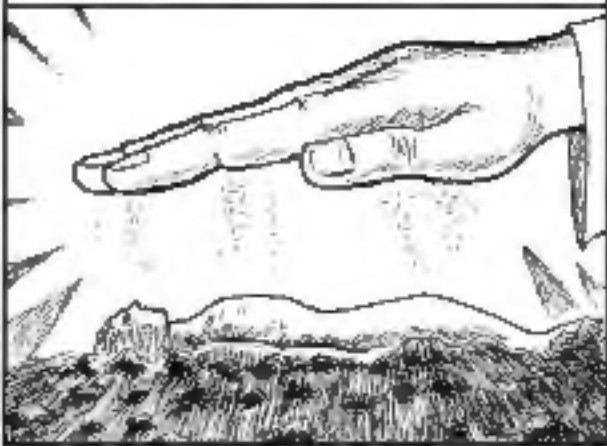
Gen. 1:24-31

my brain is reeling.

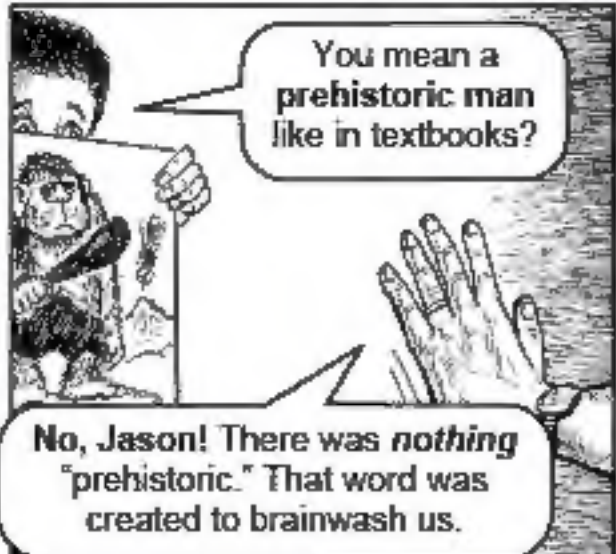
That's what the word of God

on that same day, Jason.


And God said, "Let us make man in *our* image, after our likeness." Gen. 1:26

They were found in Glen Rose, Texas... God doesn't lie.



Roughly 5000 years ago

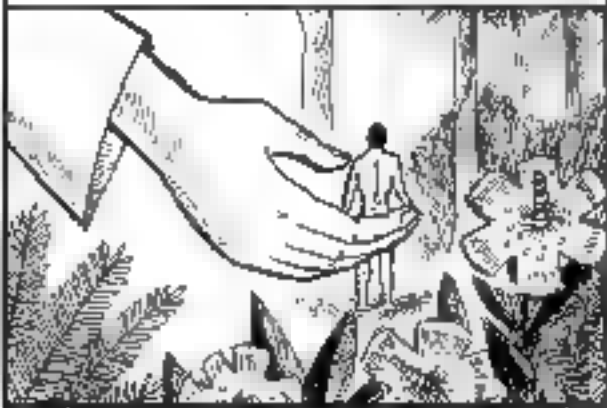
Then what I've been taught in school, films and magazines is all phony.



There were no prehistoric men Jason Before Day One there was no world

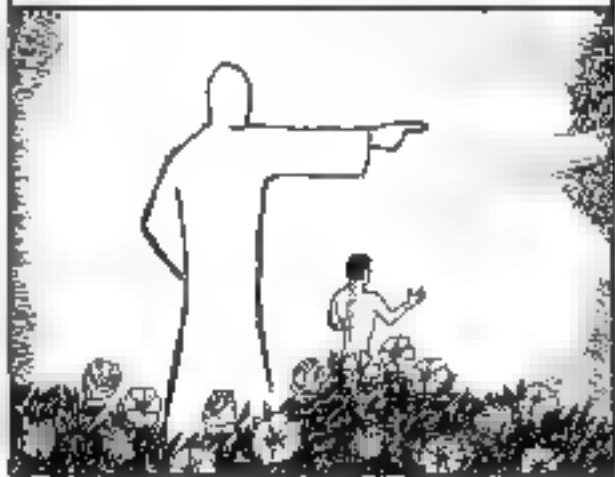
Adam was our *first* relative and you're going to hate what he did to you.

The instant Adam was created he could speak and God put him in the Garden of Eden.



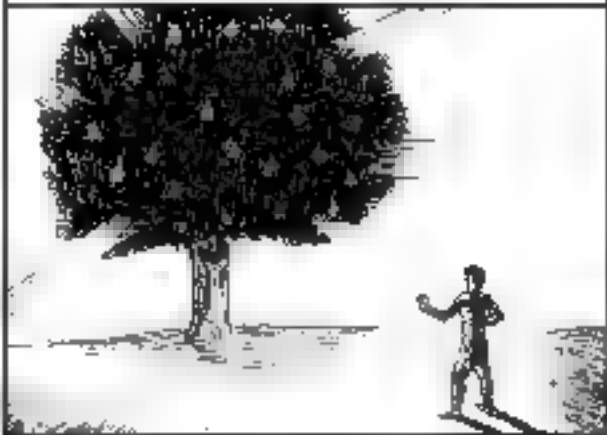
After creation, God rested on the 7th Day He saw that everything was good.

"But of the tree of knowledge of good and evil Thou shalt not eat of it.



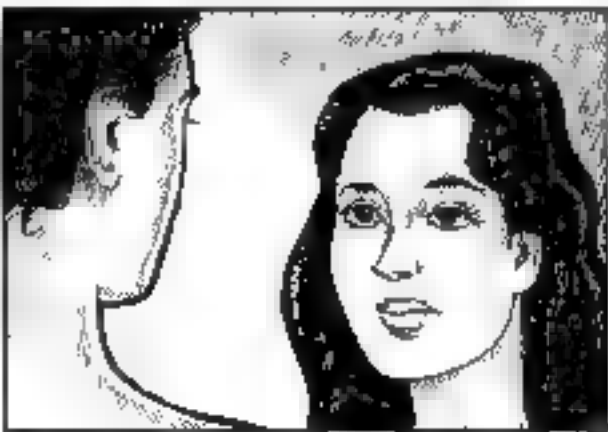
"For in the day thou *eatest* thereof thou shalt surely die." Gen. 2:16-17

and God saw that he was lonely**



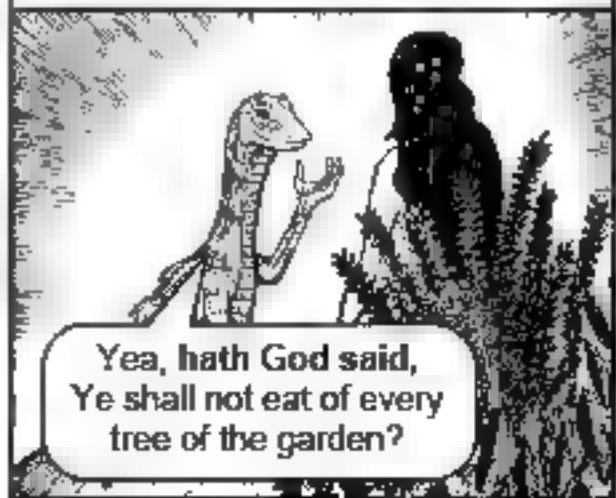
**So God created Eve to help him

She took Adam to the tree



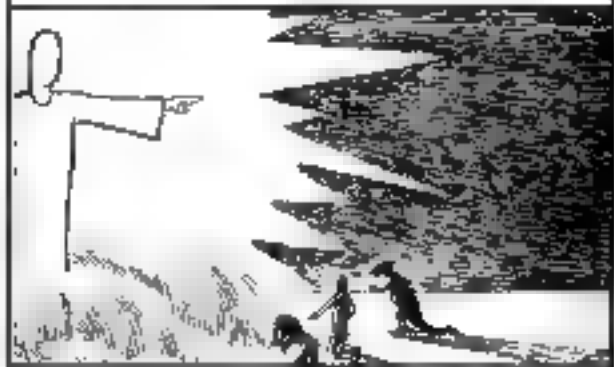
Although Adam *knew this was

Even if it meant their deaths, they ate of the fruit anyway they lost their innocence.



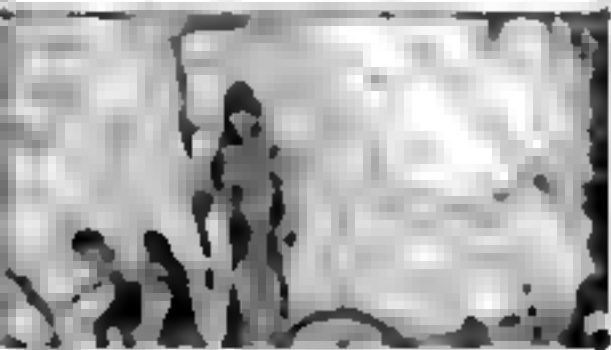
The time came to face God and give an account for their crime


Jason,

At death our bodies will go back to dust just like Adam. But where do our souls go?

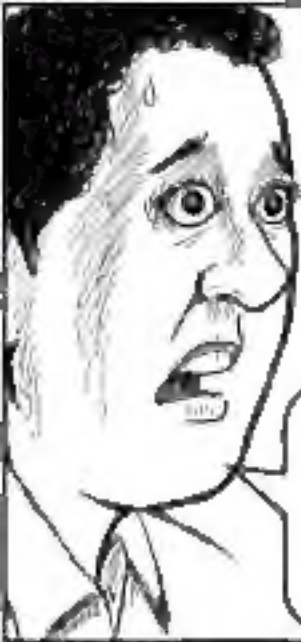
How would I know?

Absolutely nothing, Jason, because you are going to die in your sins unless

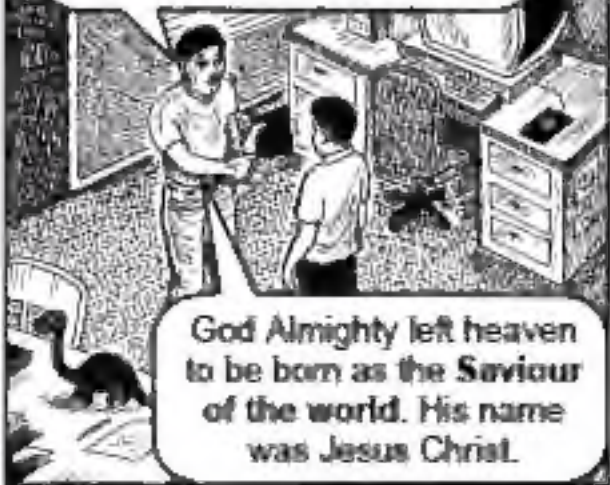
Oh man, I'm in real trouble. Thanks Adam!
