God told Noah to build the Ark... and gave him exact dimensions.

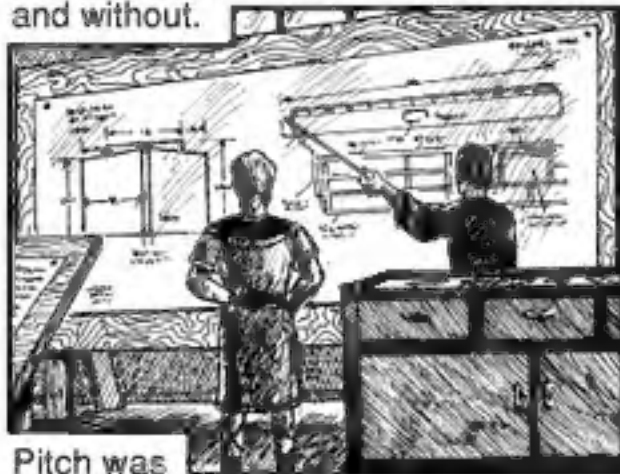
"The length of the ark shall be three hundred cubits,* the breadth of it fifty cubits, and the height of it thirty cubits."**

It was to contain 3 decks and many rooms. It looked like a giant cargo ship.

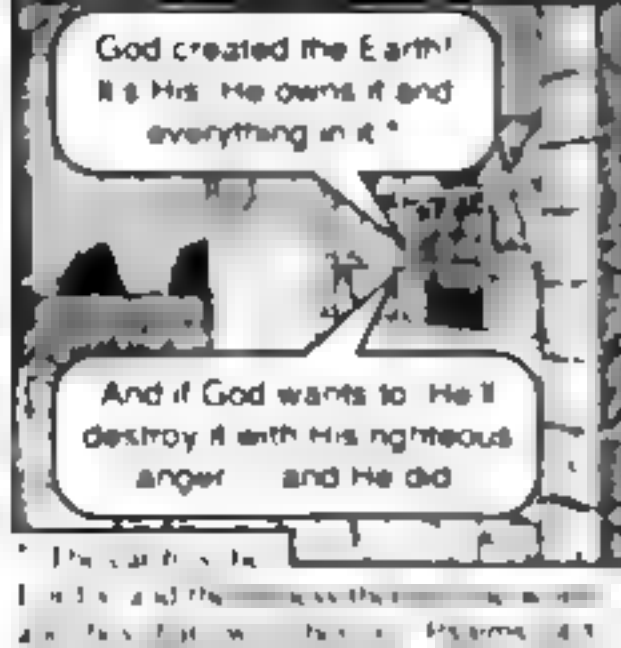


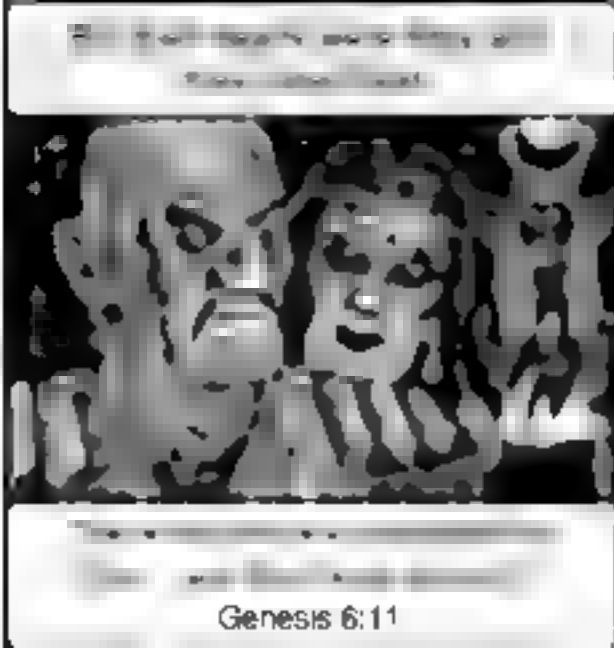
This Ark would save Noah, his family and the animals God had chosen.

He would destroy all the people — with the Earth.





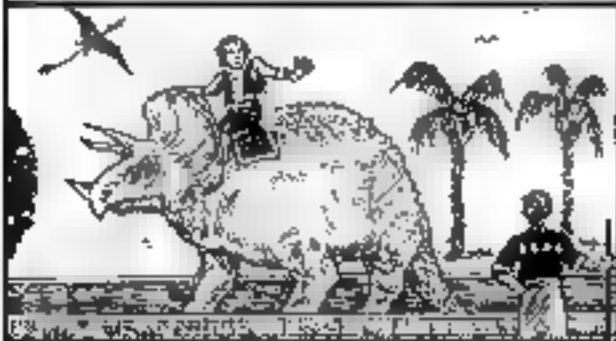
Genesis 6:11

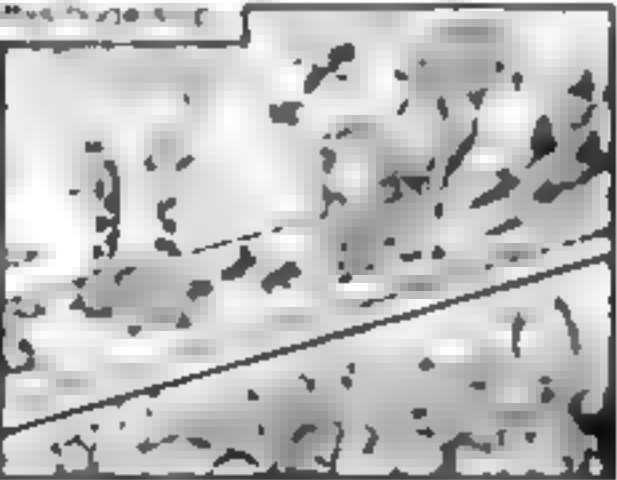

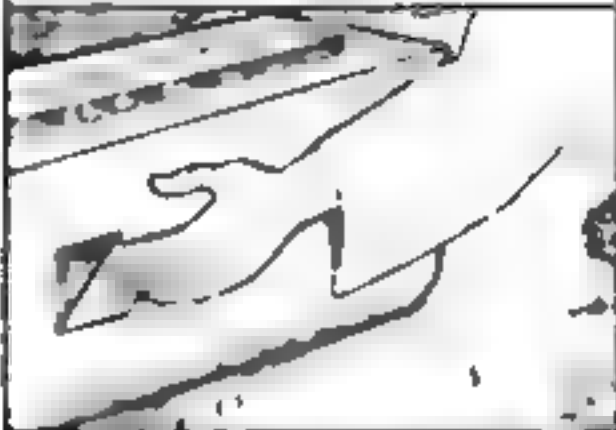

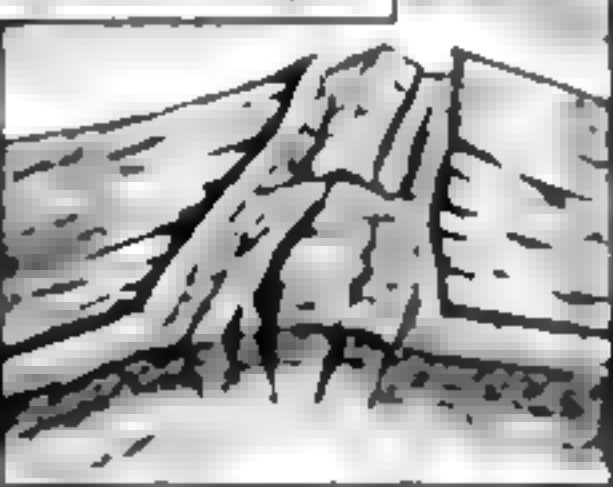
Once inside, God shut the door...

the mountains of the snow into the atmosphere



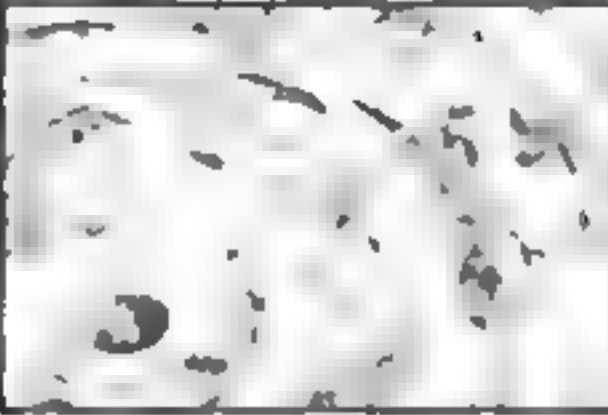
At the same time the great

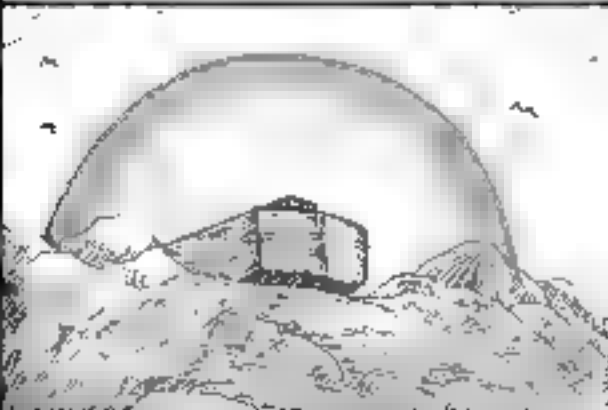
