


THE LAST


One day Eli saw a woman crying as she prayed. She told God that if she could have a son, she'd give him to the Lord.""


"Judges 21:25 **1 Samuel 1:11

Everything will change for the worst. When you complain, God will not hear.


They didn't care... They wanted a king. But they got more than they bargained for. Their new king was named Saul. At first he was shy and listened to God.

Saul was in deep trouble with God! And it cost him his kingdom.





Saul took 210 000 soldiers and wiped out the Amaiekites

And Samac Newed (cut) Agag in proces before the Lord in Grigal in Samout 15.33. Then he said to Saul






Now the Lord left Saul, and he had to face his problems alone.

Samuel was a godly and righteous judge. He never took a bribe and never let people influence his decisions. because he knew that one day he will face the greatest undge of all



















Jesus Christ was already executed for our crimes! Let me explain...
