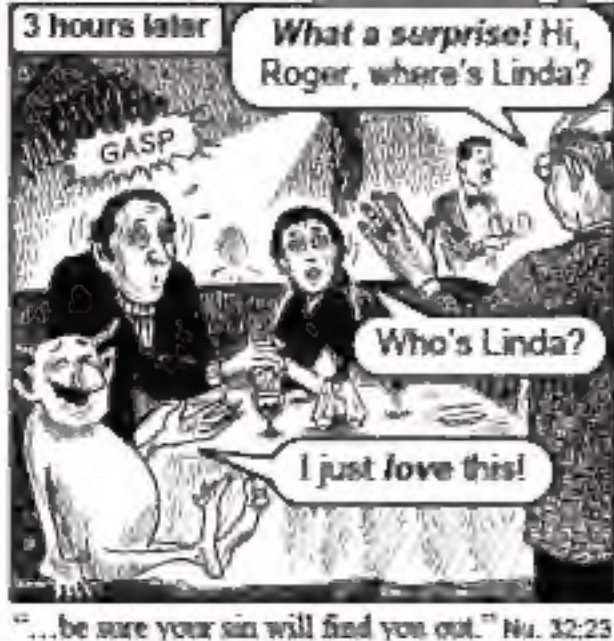






I was trying to comfort a lady in our church and my wife became jealous and accused me of doing the unthinkable...

You didn't answer me, Roger.




I guess you can say it was a harmless little fling. You know...

His brothers were at war with the Philistines. They were facing a giant named Goliath.

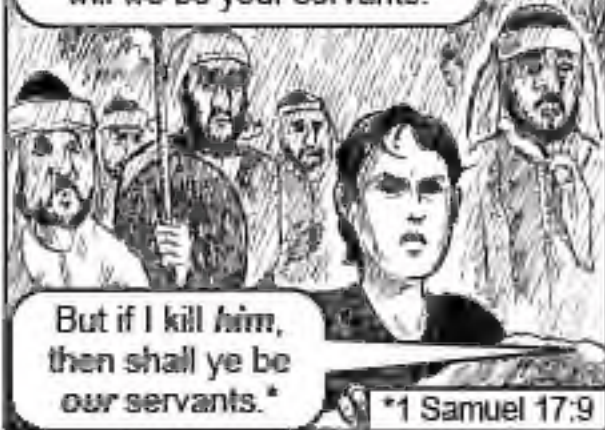


I *defy* the armies of Israel this day...

David wasn't being nice. He was trying to get off the hook. He wanted Uriah to sleep with Bathsheba so they could say the baby was Uriah's.

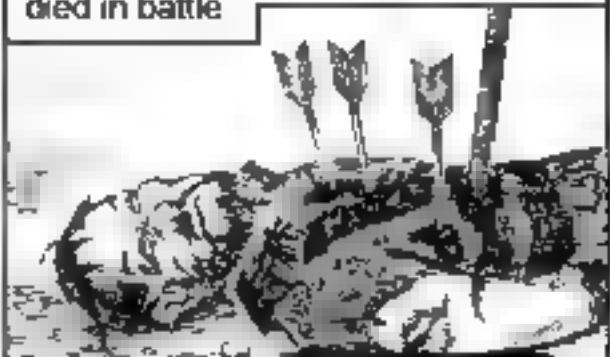
David got him drunk and tried to send him home

The Lord Jesus Christ left heaven and allowed Himself to be crucified. He shed His precious blood to wash away *your* sins.


"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."
