This story is found in many editions of *Foxe's Book of Martyrs*.

Thomas Hawkes was a gracious man, loved by all. He believed God's word.



But a new queen took over England, who was known as "Bloody Mary". She was out to get everyone who opposed the teachings of Catholicism.

Hawkes refused to have his baby baptized by a Catholic priest.

I will *not* have my child baptized by a priest of *Rome*.



Then change your *religion* or be *burnt* at the *stake*!

I *cannot* change!

In prison

I *cannot* deny Christ and His Gospel. God will help me bear the pain.

If God gives you the strength to withstand the pain... give us a sign.

I will.

Hawkes told his friends... if the pain was bearable, he would lift up his hands toward heaven as a signal before he died.



The crowd had *no idea* what they were about to witness.

The flames were so fierce he couldn't speak. As his body shrunk down, they thought he was dead... then suddenly...

Clap!

He lifted his hands over his head and clapped three times. **God** was with him in the flames.

everyone to worship it.

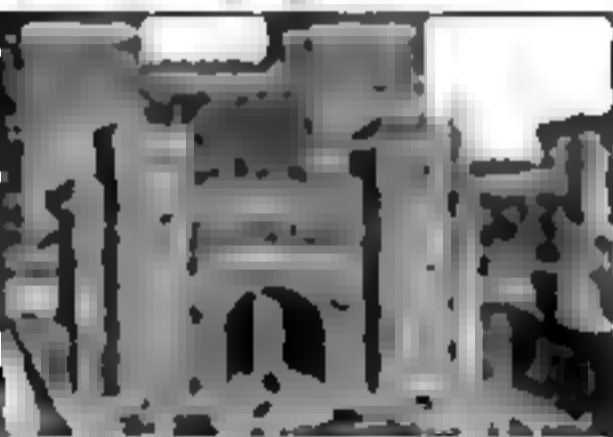
But the Israelites were *forbidden*

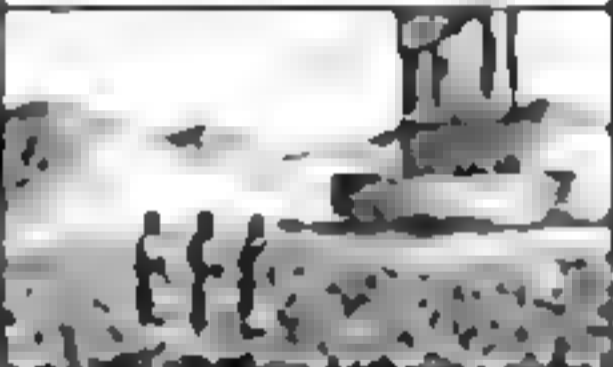


The building is a great example of

into the furnace and saw four men!






Now I see 4 men loose walking

Nebuchadnezzar was right it really was the Son of God. Rick

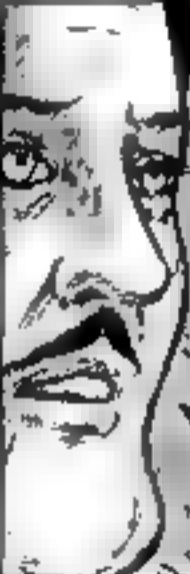
Who is the Son of God?

If He is *God*, then *why* did He let those guys *crucify* Him?


To save your soul, Rick.

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” John 3:16


He died, was buried and 3 days later He arose from the dead.




If you believe this, Rick, and receive the Lord Jesus as your Saviour, you will go to heaven.




What if I *don't*?
