happy!

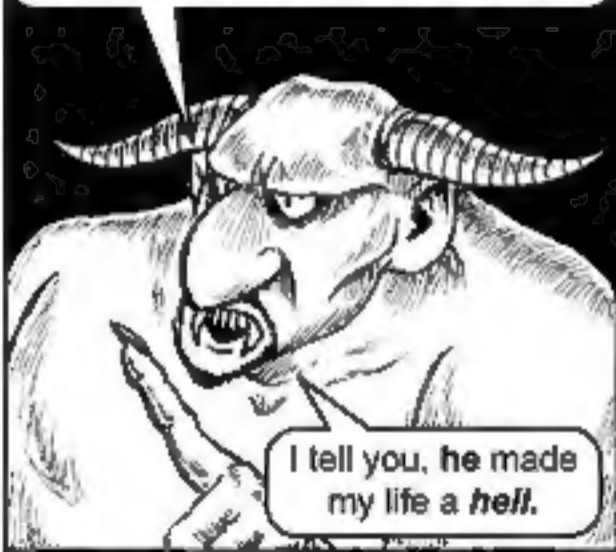

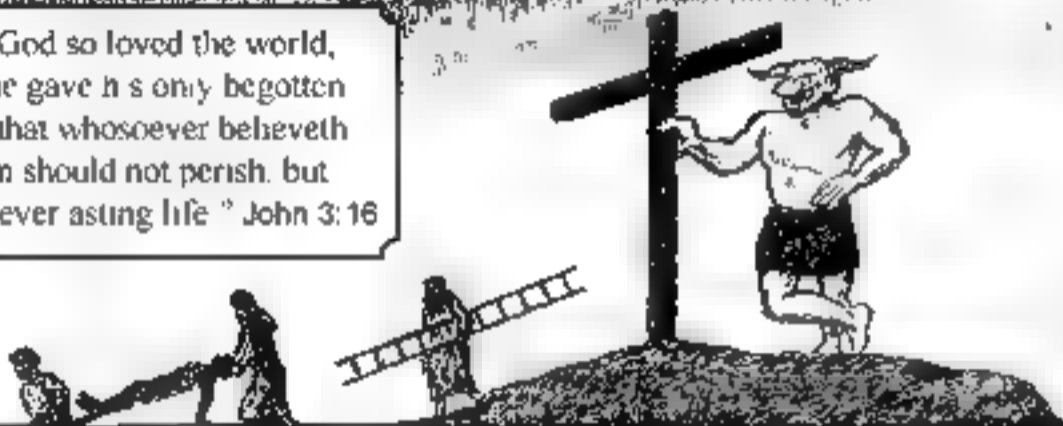


God said all you sinners must die

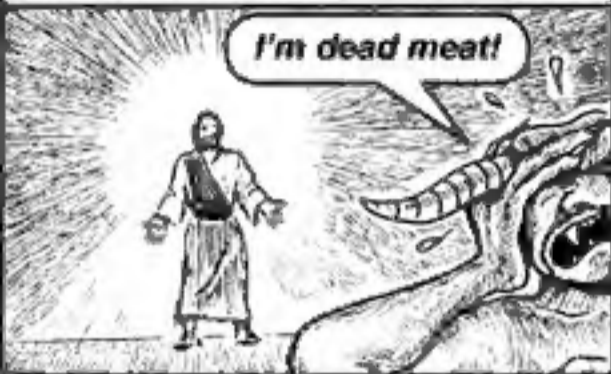
For six long hours I watched Him die in front of me

Jesus or they'd go to heaven.

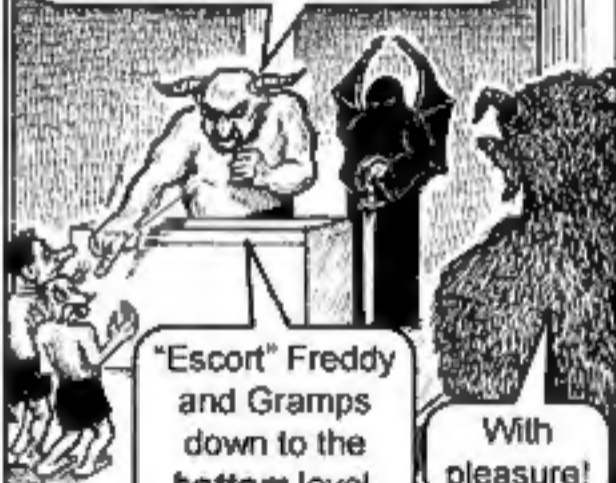
*2 Corinthians 4:3-4
