

Our topic for today: "When is it okay for Christians to lie?"

We've got a caller on line 2.
You're on the air!



It's okay for Christians
to lie, after all...

*Jesus lied to His
own brothers!*

What? Where does it say that?

It's easy. It's in John,
chapter 7. Check it out!



Could this caller's
Bible actually be
calling **Jesus** a liar?

Yep! All because
of *one* little
missing word.



His Bible said.



John 7:8-10

"You go up to the feast. I am not going up to this feast, for my time is not yet fully come. After saying this, he remained in Galilee. But after his brothers had gone up to the feast, then he also went up, not publicly but in private."



Here Jesus said, "I'm not going,"
but He went anyway.

This Bible said Jesus lied,
because one tiny word is missing...

That word is "yet."
Here's what John 7:8 **REALLY** says:



"...I go not up yet unto this feast;
for my time is not yet full come."

Jesus said He wasn't yet going up to
Jerusalem, but would go *later*.

The Lord Jesus **ALWAYS**
told the truth.*

*See John 1:17; 8:45-46; 14:6.

What a difference a word makes!

There are 20 popular Bibles missing this word.



Get a different Bible — one that's not missing anything.

But there's more...

Publishers have been quietly removing words out of Bibles for years.

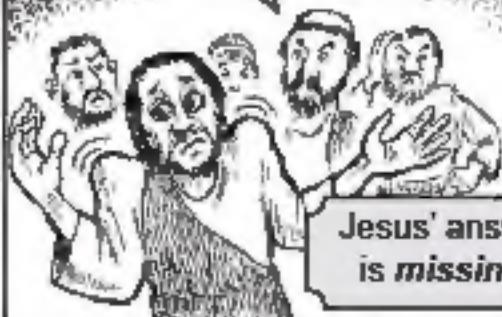


Take a look at these examples:

Which Bible would you trust?

Bible A:

"...Lord, wilt thou that we bid fire to come down from heaven, and consume them?"



Jesus' answer is *missing!*

Bible B:

"...Lord, wilt thou that we command fire to come down from heaven, and consume them, even as Elias* did?"



"...the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them."

Which one is like *your* Bible? (Check Luke 9:54-56 for yourself!)

*Elijah

Wait a minute! They took out Jesus' words!



How could they do that?

I thought all Bibles said the *same* thing!



You're in for a shock...

Do you believe in infant baptism?



Of course not! You've got to believe in Christ before you can be baptized.

Babies are too young to believe!

Oh yeah? And where do you find *that*?

In Acts 8:36, the Ethiopian Eunuch asks what he must do to get baptized
In verse 37 is the answer. What is it?




Let's see 36 38 Hey!
Verse 37 is missing!

You're not alone.
It's missing in 29 popular Bibles.

The *real* Bible says this. "And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."

of them.

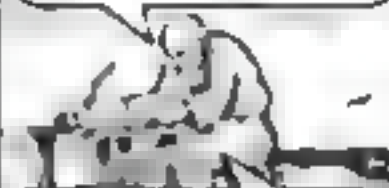


It is the word of God which is added
