Many of God's people hated these Assyrians.



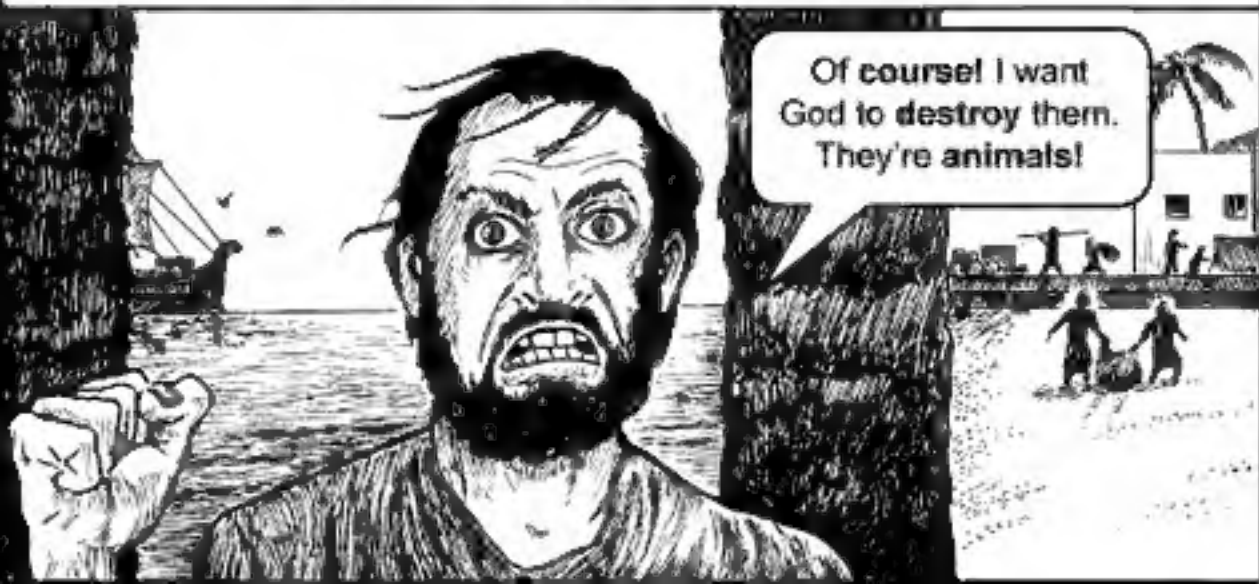
(Who did you think I was referring to?)

...than those *terrorists* repent and be forgiven.



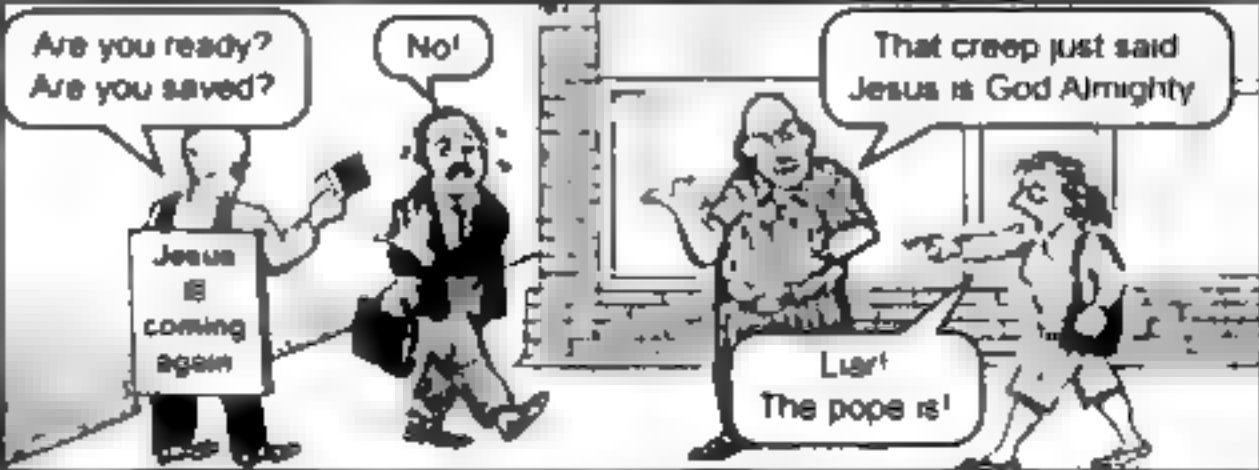
If I disappear God'll

Jonah was a "hater." And like many haters, he justified his own hatred of these lost Assyrians. So what did he do?

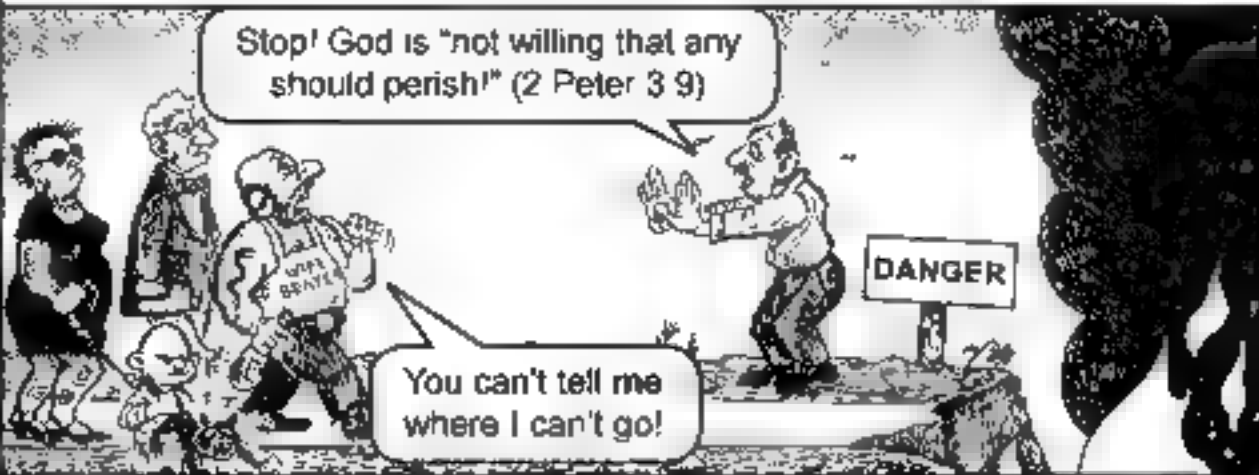


Many times Bible-believing Christians are labeled "haters" but for the opposite reason



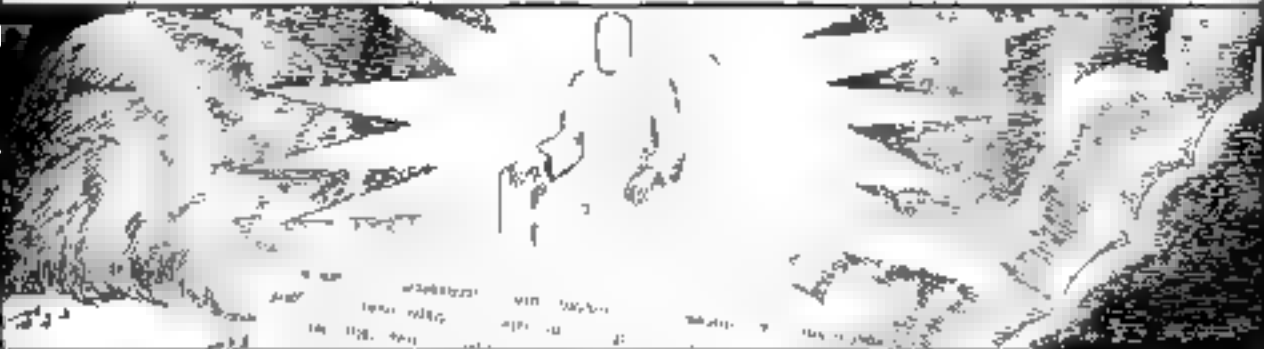
For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness, but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. 1 Corinthians 1:18

The unbelievers think that our warning about God's judgment and the lake of fire shows hatred toward them



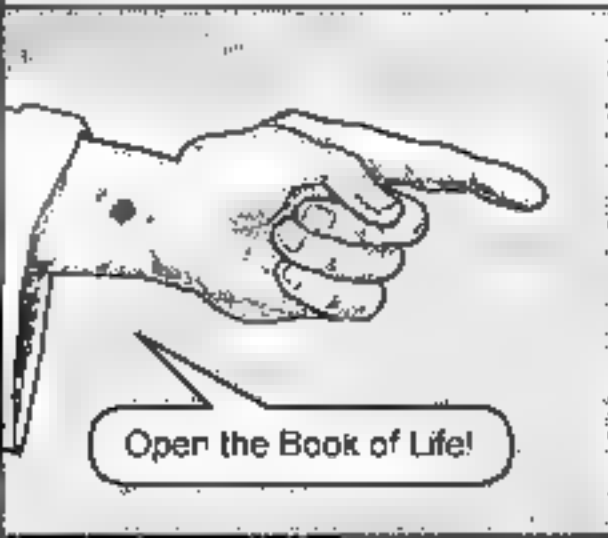
Quite the oppositel

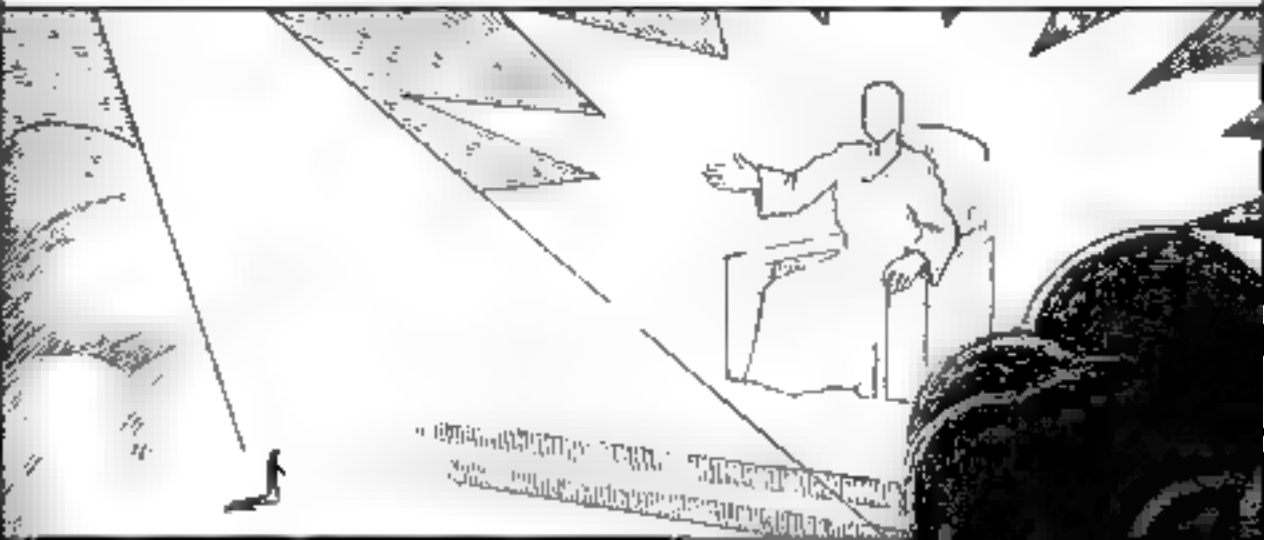
We love them so much that we don't want their works to be judged
