save us from ending up in hell?

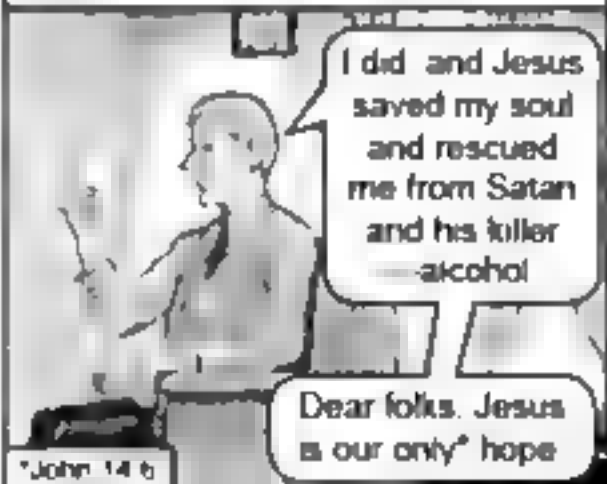
When Jesus died on the cross, He shed His holy blood to wash away every sin ever committed

Dear folks, Jesus is our only hope

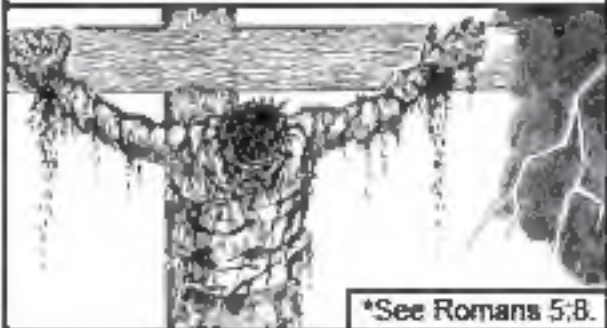
*John 14:6
