And he has virgins chained to the wall.


That's horrible! Why?

creatures —man.

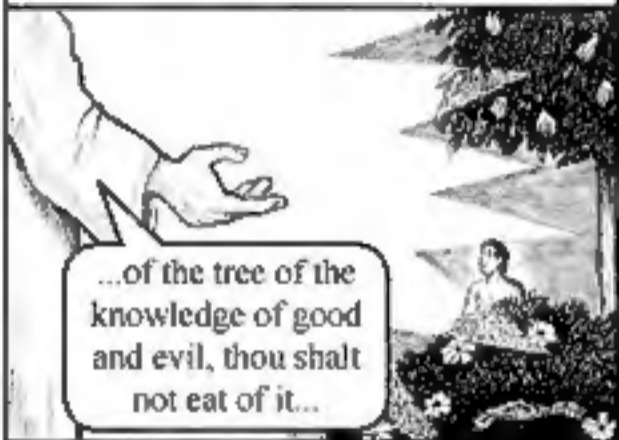
The King loved the man and

Their firstborn child was a murderer. Each new batch of kids was worse than the ones before.



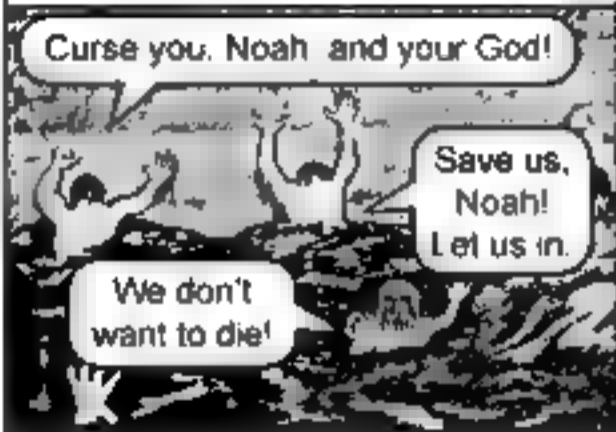
Wickedness was everywhere, so God decided to destroy them all.

They insulted God.

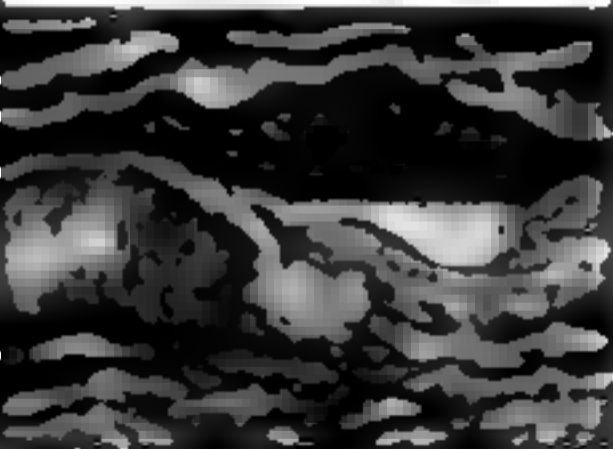
God sent a world-wide flood, killing everyone on earth.

were saved



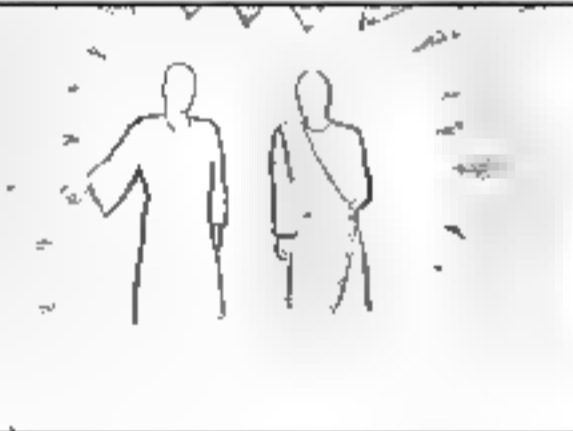
This judgment was by water

wicked hearts. But what?

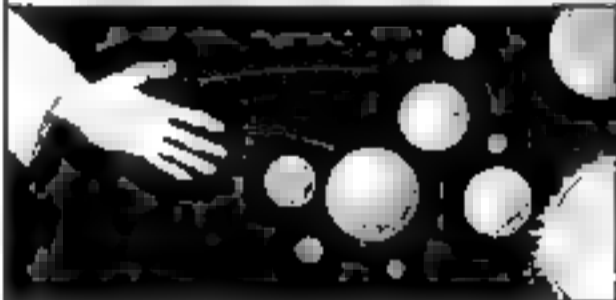
God sent His only begotten Son*

How does He know this?




He knows Moses' law better than we do!

At 30 years old, God showed John the Baptist who Jesus really was.

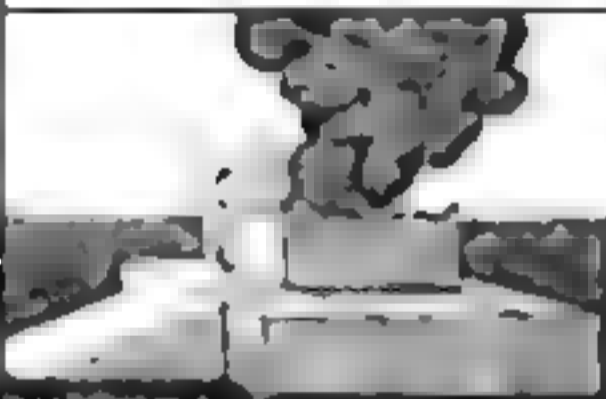


Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.*

**John 5:22

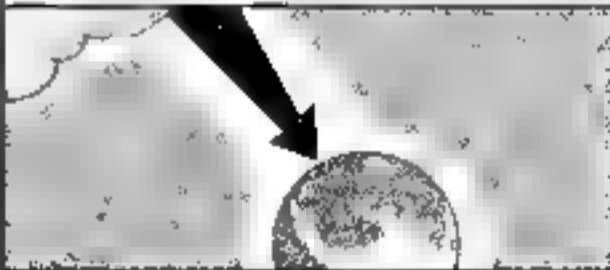
Jesus judged the world guilty in Noah's day. The sentence: destruction by a world-wide flood

their place.

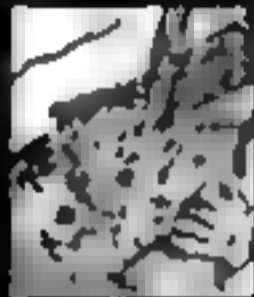


'All we like sheep have gone astray, we
