**Gen. 2:18


God wanted a helper who was just right for Adam.

“...and brought *them* unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof.” Genesis 2:19




Would Adam find a helper from the animals that was “just right” (meet)?


Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.*"

To be "one flesh," the man needed a woman as his wife. And it was good. Anything else is not good.


*Genesis 2:23-24

Thou shalt not eat from this tree.





for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die (Genesis 2:17)





He paid the price, and gave us the way back to God.


If you believe that Jesus died for you, and ask Him to forgive your sin,
