\*Genesis 3:4-5

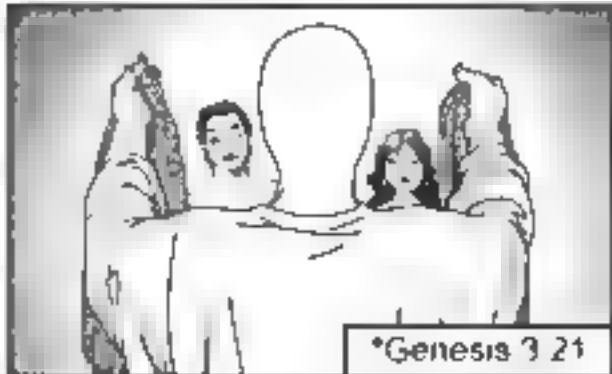
Eve, then Adam with her, ate.

You must *admit to God* that you are a sinner who needs forgiveness, and that you can't make it to heaven on your own terms



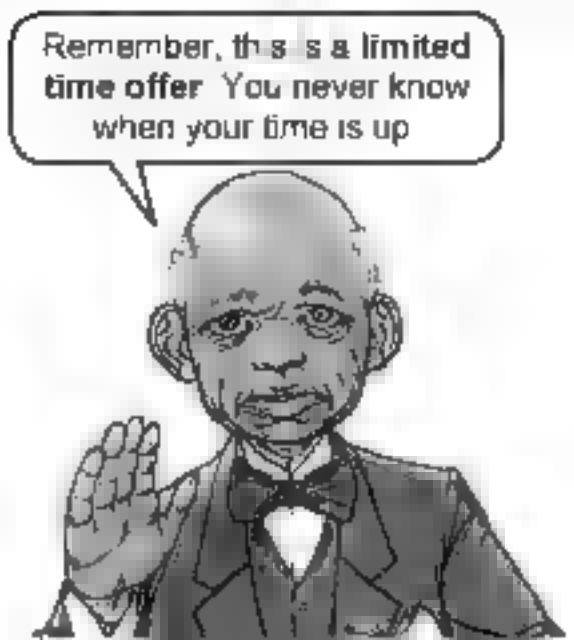
Wait—that's too easy!
