







Many years ago, a poor woman moved to a country that didn't like her kind.




Her name was Ruth. She was recently widowed and came with her widowed mother-in-law.








Boaz remembered the famine that had hit Israel years earlier.

Naomi's husband, Elimelech, died while they were in Moab.





Boaz had learned how Ruth had decided to help Naomi.




But Boaz also did his part, to make sure Ruth was well provided for.




But he never dreamed of how God would provide for *him!* Ruth and Naomi lived on the extra food. But what would they do after harvest? One day

Naomi had Ruth find where Boaz wept on the last night of harvest. So she crept up




and uncovered Boaz's feet in the cool right air. Then she warted At midnight. Boaz was startied awake by the cold and a woman!

Boaz married Ruth the outsider who trusted God. You see it doesn't matter where we come from









Her first thought was for her family s safety
