


## SNOWFLAKE?


Some snowflakes avoid responsibility...

according to the Bible, this started way up in heaven! shouldn't I be worshipped? After all, I'm perfect!


People want their own selfish way. Believe it or not,



Satan tricked Eve into feeling that God was holding out on her.


And it worked! Selfishness is contagious: from Lucifer to Eve. then to Adam. I know it's wrong. but And so Adam also ate from the tree of knowledge,

Except Jesus He did no sin,\*\* so He had no sin to pay for




But Jesus was in heaven. How on earth could He help us?
