Can't you see him?


A man in a hospital bed says, "I don't see anything."

*Romans 6:23




At judgment day, anyone who isn't clean and forgiven can't go where God is. He must be driven out of His presence

Yes. "And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire." Revelation 20:15






You must believe

What did he do?


"For God so loved the

But He didn't stay there




Three days later, Jesus walked out of

The Third Day




Hi, Son. How's Grandpa today?
