AMENDMENT NO. 11 to CIRCULAR NO. 70.

By virtue of the authority vested in the Secretary of Agriculture by the United States grain standards Act of August 11, 1916, (39 United States Statutes at Large, page 482), I, D. F. Houston, Secretary of Agriculture, do make, prescribe, publish, and give public notice of, the following amendment to the rules and regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, dated November 6, 1916, under said Act, said amendment to be effective immediately.

Amend regulation 2, section 14, paragraph 3, so as to read as follows:

Paragraph 3. No certificate of grade shall be issued under the Act until its form has been approved by the Chief of the Bureau of Markets, except as permitted in paragraph 4 of this section.
