AMENDMENT NO. 12 TO CIRCULAR NO. 70 REVISED.

By virtue of the authority vested in the Secretary of Agriculture by the United States grain standards Act of August 11, 1916 (39 U. S. Stat. at Large, page 482), I, W. M. Jardine Secretary of Agriculture, do make, prescribe, publish, and give public notice of the following amendment to the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, dated July 30, 1920, as revised under said Act, said amendment to be effective immediately.

In Regulation 2, insert a new section, 31-a, as follows:

"Sec. 31-a. No licensed inspector shall issue, nor permit to be issued over his signature, any copy of a certificate of inspection which has been superseded by a Federal Appeal Grade Certificate, without first notifying the district grain supervisor and securing his approval of such issuance."
