Amendment No. 5 to Circular No. 70, Revised.



By virtue of the authority vested in the Secretary of Agriculture by the United States grain standards Act of August 11, 1916, (39 United States Statutes at Large, p. 482), I, Henry C. Wallace, Secretary of Agriculture, do make, prescribe, publish, and give public notice of the following amendment to the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, dated July 30, 1920, as revised, under said Act, said amendment to be effective July 1, 1923.

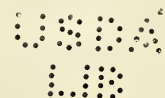
In Regulation 2, Section 23 amend Paragraph (m) to read as follows:

(m) unless issued for an export shipment, a statement of the factor or factors which determined the grade, except in the case of grade No. 1, to which may be added any other factor, or the complete analysis, and for inspections of wheat, oats and rye shall include the test weight per bushel, whether such factor determined the grade or not, as follows: In the case of oats the test weight shall be given in terms of whole and half pounds, for which purpose a fraction of a pound when equal to or greater than a half shall be treated as a half, and when less than a half shall be disregarded; in the case of wheat and rye, the test weight shall be given in whole pounds and tenths of a pound;
