AMENDMENT NO. 7 to CIRCULAR NO. 70.

By virtue of the authority vested in the Secretary of Agriculture by the United States grain standards Act of August 11, 1916

(39 United States Statutes at Large, page 452), I, David F. Houston,
Secretary of Agriculture, do make, prescribe, publish, and give
public notice of, the following amendment to the rules and regulations
of the Secretary of Agriculture, dated November 6, 1916, under said
Act, said amendment to be effective immediately:

In Regulation 2; insert a new section as follows:

Sec. 17. No licensed inspector shall, directly or indirectly by any means whatsoever, deter or prevent or attempt to deter or prevent any party from taking an appeal to the Secretary of Agriculture.
