

PROGRAMS

Some of the events coordinated by Al Hidayah Centre:

PUBLIC

1. Qirat Jalsas

Three Qirat Jalsas at several Masjids with Qurraa including Qari Abdur Rahmaan Sadien, Qari Muhammad Binyameena and Qari Mustaqeem Paulse.

2. Hajj Classes

Practical, in-depth classes for prospective Hujjaj over two sessions.

3. Umrah Class

Comprehensive class covering the practical and spiritual process of Umrah. This was also made into an audio-visual series.

4. Moon Sighting for Ramadaan and Eid

Annual event that saw over 250 fathers and sons come out to fulfill the Sunnah.

5. Seerah Series

Annual event coordinated at 12 Masjids this year. Bringing alive practical aspects of the Sunnah.

6. Murshid Al Qari Completion

Third group of Hifz students completed the course of Murshid Al Qari. Completion and certificates done by Qari Saleem Gaibie.

7. Marriage Workshop

Two part series conducted at Masjid Saaliheen. Covering the Figh and practical aspects.

8. Wills Week Outreach

Workshop on South African law and Wills in conjunction with the Department of Justice and Constitutional Development.

9. West End Eidgah for Eidul Fitr

Attracted over 800 people. Eidul Adha was held at Masjids due to the cold weather.

10. Palestine Solidarity Programs

At five Masjids to highlight the Gaza genocide.

11. Visiting Ulama

Al Hidayah arranged and coordinated programs for over 20 Ulama at various Masjids over the course of the year.

ULAMA/HUFFAAZ

1. Hifz and Tajweed Workshops

For Huffaaz and teachers.

2. Figh and Qirat

Conducted by Qari Mustaqeem Paulse for Ulama and Apas.

3. Tajweed Classes

Teaching of Murshid Al Qari parts one and two.

MASJIDS

1. Application of Criminal Law

Presentation and notes on application of South African criminal law within the Masjid and Maktab systems. Conducted by Advocate M.N. Sandan.

YOUTH

1. Girls YOi Program

Ramadaan readiness program for high school girls.

2. Youth Itikaaf at Masjid Noor

Ramadaan Program designed to connect youth to the Masjid. 64 kids participated.

3. Girls Qirat Program

Afternoon of Qirat and the Noble Quran at Darul Quran Institute. Around 80 participants.

4. Qirat Nights

Popular Qirat Program for Hifz Madressas. Over 300 people in total attended the three editions at Masjids Saaliheen, Maseeh and Salaam.

5. Schools Program

Structured weekly classes at 6 northern areas high schools. Ulama also conduct monthly assemblies.

6. Exam Preparation

Programs conducted at high schools with Mufti Yusuf Moosagie. Around 230 Muslim students were equipped with the tools for studying.

7. Practical Qurbani

Held at Madressa Mansoor and Nasruddin High.

8. Matric Orientation and Career Day

Empowering learner to keep their identity. Career options also presented at Masjid Taqwa.

PUBLICATIONS

Al Hidayah Centre undertakes translation of important works into Afrikaans and Xhosa. We use Ulama who are fluent native speakers in those languages to ensure the language is correct and easy to understand.

We also produce selected works in English as well as coordinate distribution of books.


Collaboration


Al Hidayah Centre collaborated with Muslims First on book design and layout of the publication, Reforming Yourself.

10. Malabar Graveyard


Campaign to increase the cemetery.
