HONORARY DEGREES

Doctor of Science—Henry Crew

Professor emeritus of Northwestern University since 1930<sup>7</sup>; associated with the Department of Physics at Northwestern University as professor from 1892 to 1930: past president of the American Physical Society, the History of Science Society, the American Association of University Professors: delegate in 1900 to the Congress of Physicists held in Paris: chief of the Division of Basic Sciences of the Century of Progress Exposition, 1930-1933: a distinguished scholar, author of numerous scientific articles and books, honored by election to noted societies: known also as an active protagonist of the fundamental sciences in their presentation and progress: a gentleman of poise and tact.

### Doctor of Literature—George Oliver Curme

A teacher distinguished equally for his scholarly achievements, his enthusiasm in the class-room and his influence on his students: author of *A Grammar of the German Language* which has made his name known wherever that language is taught: author of *English Syntax* and various other books: contributor to learned journals in Germany and America: Professor of Germanic philology at Northwestern University for 39 years: honored by the Modern Language Association of America by election to the presidency, the highest distinction in his profession: a man whose kindness, sincerity, and unaffected modesty have endeared him to all who know him.

### Doctor of Literature—James Taft Hatfield

### Doctor of Laws—Thomas Franklin Holgate

Completing forty-four years of distinguished service for Northwestern University as professor of mathematics; for seventeen years Dean of the College of Liberal Arts; twice acting president of the University; an invaluable aid in the educational work of the Methodist Church; his strength and steadfastness have been an inspiration in trying times; his sincere friendliness has won for him the deep personal affection of his colleagues, and of thousands of students and alumni.

### Doctor of Laws—James Alton James

Professor at Northwestern University from 1897 to 1935, for thirty years head of its Department of History and for eighteen years Dean of its Graduate School; exponent of painstaking research in early midwestern history, widely-recognized biographer, productive member and occasional chief executive of state, regional and national historical organizations; practical protagonist of moral reform, inter-church unity, and international peace; a wise and trusted student counsellor, an inspiring colleague, a helpful neighbor, an active participant in every worthy community activity.

### Doctor of Laws—John Henry Wigmore
