



HONORARY DEGREES

DOCTOR OF LAWS—Clarence Addison Dykstra

Professor and outstanding teacher of Political Science in three of America's State Universities; active participant and leader in the civic life of locality, state and nation; organizer and director of private associations for better government through informed and active citizenship; for eight years chief executive of the city of Cincinnati, first among the larger cities of America for democratic, efficient, progressive and humane government; now President of the University of Wisconsin. A man of vision but never a visionary; a courageous but always constructive critic of governmental forms and political practices; a scholar who has linked scholarship with political and social action; a man whose kindness and tolerance has never been a cloak for timidity; a public administrator who by his work as well as by his words has pushed

forward the conception of efficient public administration as essential to the success of political democracy; a man who in all his connections and positions, whether public or private, has been and remains fundamentally an educator.

### DOCTOR OF LAWS—George Horace Gallup

An outstanding figure in American Journalism whose research has given the American press a scientific method of determining the interests of its readers as a means to the production of better newspapers; a man who has developed the first scientific method of measuring public opinion and who has through his American Institute of Public Opinion and his writings for the leading newspapers of the country contributed immeasurably to the clarification of thinking on public issues; an advertising executive whose work has set new milestones in business research; a former teacher of Journalism at Northwestern University who has done much to lift the standards of education for Journalism.

### DOCTOR OF DIVINITY—Emory Wylie Luccock

Beloved pastor with a worthy record of consecrated service in America and the Far East, he has given himself unstintedly to meet the educational needs and to further the social welfare of the Chinese people; eloquent and convincing interpreter of Oriental life and persistent in the pursuit of every practical path toward universal peace and goodwill, he has shown himself a consistent exponent of the Christian approach to statecraft; richly endowed with humor, sympathy, originality and good judgment, he has devoted himself to a socialized gospel that appeals equally to individual spiritual experience and to an enlightened program of human betterment.

### DOCTOR OF SCIENCE—Francis Wylton Reichelderfer

Distinguished scientist, pioneer in the development of the meteorological service essential to aviation; twice Councilor and former Fellow of the American Meteorological Society; Scientific and Honorary member of the Institute of the Aeronautical Sciences; member of the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics; studied at the Meteorological Institutes in Bergen, Paris, and London; established training school for U. S. Naval Aerographers, and instigated the graduate course in meteorology at Massachusetts Institute of Technology; inaugurated first regular aerological soundings by airplane in the United States, and one of the leaders in introducing weather map analysis by fronts and air masses in this country; enrolled in the United States Naval Reserve in 1918, was transferred to the regular Navy in 1920, and to the inactive list of the Navy with the rank of Commander in January, 1939, in order to accept the appointment as Chief of the United States Weather Bureau.

By his outstanding contributions to the field of meteorological and aerological development he has brought great credit to Northwestern University from which he graduated with an A.B. degree, Science Major, in 1917, and to the United States Navy which he served so well.
