THE HONORARY DEGREES

In the Exercises, citations will be read by Payson S. Wild, Vice-President and Dean of Faculties of Northwestern University.

JEROME SEYMOUR BRUNER - DOCTOR OF SCIENCE

A graduate of Duke University (A.B., 1937), he went for graduate study to Harvard (A.M., 1939; Ph.D., 1941), where he has spent most of his professional life: research, 1945-; Professor of Psychology, 1952-; Director of Center for Cognitive Studies, 1961-; Syndic of the Harvard Press, 1962-63. He has been a lecturer to the Salzburg Seminar, 1952; a consultant on psychological problems to the Departments of State, Navy, and Defense; a member of the Research Advisory Panel of the General Electric Corporation, 1959-; Chairman, the Curriculum Study Group of the National Academy of Sciences, 1959-61; a member of the White House Panel on Educational Research and Development; and a Guggenheim Fellow, Cambridge University, 1955. From the American Psychological Association of which he is a Fellow he received the Distinguished Science Contribution Award in 1962. Editor: Public Opinion Quarterly, 1943-44. Author: Mandate from the People, 1941; The Process of Education, 1960; On Knowing: Essays for the Left Hand, 1962.

ORLANDO WINFIELD WILSON - DOCTOR OF LAWS

Criminologist and educator. While a student at the University of California (A.B., 1924), he worked as a police officer in Berkeley. After holding two posts as Chief of Police: at Fullerton, California, 1925-26, and at Wichita, Kansas, 1928-39, he joined the faculty of the University of California, Berkeley, as Professor of Police Administration. In 1950 he was appointed Dean of the School of Police Administration, a position he held until 1960. At Harvard he was lecturer to the Bureau of Street Traffic Research in 1937. He has also been police consultant to the Public Administration Service of Chicago, 1939-43, and to the Insular Government of Puerto Rico, 1951. From 1943 until 1947 he served as Lieutenant Colonel, and later as Colonel, in the United States Army Corps of Military Police in Germany and Italy. From 1941 until 1949 he was President of the Society for the Advancement of Criminology. Since 1960 he has been Superintendent of the Chicago Police Department. He is the author of three standard texts in the field of police administration: *Police Records*, 1942, *Police Administration*, 1950, and *Police Planning*, 1951.

WARD DARLEY - DOCTOR OF LAWS

In his long association with the University of Colorado (A.B., 1926; M.D., 1929) he served successively as Professor of Medicine, 1944-56; Dean of the Medical School; 1953-56; Vice-President, 1948-53, and President of the University, 1953-56. On many of the most important national commissions, councils, and foundations dealing with medicine he has been a member or consultant: Division of Medicine and Public Health, Rockefeller Foundation, 1952-53; Western Interstate Commission on Higher Education, 1951-56; Board of Visitors, Air University, United States Air Force, 1955-58; National Merit Scholarship Corporation (Trustee), 1955-63; Medical School Grants Advisory Committee, Ford Foundation, 1956. For fourteen years he exerted a guiding influence on the Association of American Medical Colleges, as a member of the Executive Council, 1945-51; as President, 1952-53; and particularly as Director, 1956-64. He is a member of the National Academy of Sciences. In 1964 he was given one of the highest honors in medical education, the Abraham Flexner Award.

CAROL FOX - DOCTOR OF FINE ARTS

Opera Producer. After graduation from the Girls Latin School, Chicago, she continued her education in voice studies with Giovanni Martinelli, Edith Mason, Vittorio Trevisan, Virgilio Lazzari, and teachers in Italy. In 1952 she founded the Lyric Theatre of Chicago, which became the Lyric Opera of Chicago. From 1952 to 1956 she served as its President and General Manager. Since 1956 she has been General Manager. In 1956 she was decorated Cavaliere al Merito della Repubblica Italiana.

NEWTON N. MINOW - DOCTOR OF LAWS

Executive Vice President and General Counsel Encyclopedia Britannica. Graduate of Northwestern (A.B., 1949; LL.B., 1950). Law clerk to Chief Justice of the United States Supreme Court Fred M. Vinson, 1951-52. Administrative Assistant to Governor Adlai E. Stevenson of Illinois, 1952-53. Partner of the firm Stevenson, Rifkind and Wirtz, 1957-61. Special Assistant to Adlai E. Stevenson in presidential campaigns, 1952 and 1956. Named one of America's outstanding young men of 1961. Received the Foster Peabody Broadcasting Award, 1961; and the Northwestern University Alumni Association Merit Award, 1963. Chairman of the Federal Communications Commission, 1961-64. Executive Vice President and General Counsel of the Encyclopedia Britannica since 1963.

FREDERICK SEITZ -- DOCTOR OF SCIENCE

President, National Academy of Sciences. Graduate of Stanford University (A.B., 1932) and of Princeton (Ph.D., 1934). Formerly a research physicist with the General Electric Company and a member of the faculty of University of Rochester, University of Pennsylvania, Carnegie Institute of Technology. Presently, Professor of Physics and Dean and Vice President for Research in Graduate College, University of Illinois. Chairman, governing board, American Institute of Physics, 1954-59. President, American Physical Society, 1960-61. Chairman, Naval Research Advisory Council; Vice Chairman, Defense Science Board, 1961- . President of the National Academy of Sciences since 1962. Member American Philosophical Society. Author: The Modern Theory of Solids (1940), The Physics of Metals (1943). Co-editor: Preparation and Characteristics of Solid Luminescent Materials (1948); Solid State Physics series.

LAWRENCE WILLIAM TOWNER — DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

Librarian, Newberry Library. He received his education at Cornell College, Iowa (A.B., 1942) and Northwestern University (M.A., 1950, Ph.D., 1955). During World War II he served as First Lieutenant in the United States Army Air Force. Beginning his professional career as History Master in the Chicago Latin School, 1946-47, he moved on to the professional staffs in history at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, 1950-55, and the College of William and Mary, 1955-62. He edited the *William and Mary Quarterly from* 1955 to 1961, and was a Fellow of the Harvard Center for the Study of the History of Liberty, 1961-62. As Librarian, 1962-, he was the prime mover in the Newberry Library's recent widely acclaimed acquisition of the Silver collection of rare books dealing with the Renaissance.

ROBERT E. WOOD - DOCTOR OF LAWS

Director, Sears, Roebuck and Company. A graduate of the United States Military Academy (1900), he served as Second and First Lieutenant, Third Cavalry, 1900-1902, in the United States Army during the Philippine Insurrection. From 1905 to 1915 he held positions as Assistant Chief Quartermaster, Chief Quartermaster, and Director of the Panama Railroad Company, on construction of the Panama Canal. A Colonel and later a Brigadier General during World War I, he became Acting Quartermaster General of the United States Army, 1918-19. He began his career in the business world as Assistant to the President of the General Asphalt Company, 1915-17, and as Vice-President of Montgonery Ward and Company, Chicago, 1919-24. In his long association with Sears, Roebuck and Company he has been successively Vice-President, 1924-28; President, 1928-39; Chairman of the Board, 1939-54; Chairman of the Finance Committee, 1954-57; and Director. He is also a Director of the Illinois Central Railroad and of the First National Bank of Chicago. He has been awarded the Philippine Insurrection Medal, the Panama Canal Medal, and the D.S.M., Legion of Merit. He is a Companion of the Order of St. Michael and St. George (British), and a Knight of the Legion of Honor (French).

WESLEY MOON DIXON - DOCTOR OF LAWS

After Cornell University (1914-17) and World War I, in which he served as Second Lieutenant, he made business his profession. Since 1920 he has been a corporation executive: Vice-President, Director Cornell Wood Products Company, 1920-25 and President, Dixon Board Mills, 1925-28. Sefton Manufacturing Corporation, 1928-30. Most of his career has been spent with the Container Corporation of America of which he has been in turn Vice-President and Director, 1930-46; President, 1946-61; Chairman of the Board, President, and Chief Executive Officer, 1960-61; and Chairman of the Board, 1961 through 1963. He is a member of the Board of Directors of the U. S. Gypsum Company, the Harris Trust and Savings Bank, and the Pure Oil Company. For many years he has been a Trustee of the Chicago Wesley Memorial Hospital and of Northwestern University. From 1959 to 1964, he was President of Northwestern's Board of Trustees.

FRANCIS KEPPEL - DOCTOR OF LAWS

United States Commissioner of Education. A graduate of Harvard University (A.B., 1938), he spent most of his professional career at his alma mater: Assistant Dean, Harvard College, 1939-41; Assistant to the Provost, Harvard University, 1946-48; Dean, Faculty of Education, 1948-62. During World War II he rose from the rank of private to that of First Licutenant in the U.S. Army. From 1941 to 1944 he was Secretary of the Joint Army and Navy Committee on Welfare and Recreation. He is a member of Phi Beta Kappa and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. Since 1962 he has held his present office.
