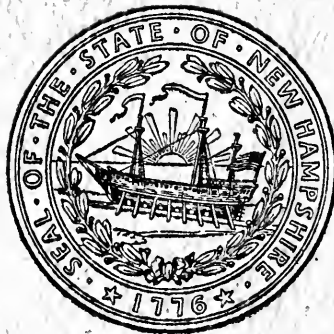

in the County of Carroll, in said State,  
qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Albany on Tuesday, the twelfth day of March, next at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose a Town Clerk for the ensuing year.
2. To choose a Town Treasurer for the ensuing year.
3. To choose a member of the Board of Selectmen for the ensuing three years.
4. To choose Road Agents, or a Road Agent for the ensuing year.
5. To choose a Tax Collector for the ensuing year.
6. To choose one or more Constables for the ensuing year.
7. To choose one or more Auditors for the ensuing year.
8. To raise and appropriate necessary sums of money for salaries and expenses.
9. To raise and appropriate necessary sums of money for highways and bridges.
10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate money for the support of the White Mts. Region Association.
11. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes, if necessary.

12. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$187.16 for Class V Highways, the State to add \$748.65 to this sum.

13. To transact any other business that may legally come before the town meeting.
