To the Inhabitants of the Town of Tuftonboro in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Town House in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the Tenth (10th) day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. \$31,230.00 Figures approved by the Budget Committee.

3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of six hundred and twenty-one dollars and forty-six cents (\$621.46), the State to contribute the sum of four thousand, one hundred and forty-three dollars and seven cents (\$4,143.07), for Town Road Aid.

4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of two hundred and thirty-five dollars and fourteen cents (\$235.14), for the Lakes Region Association.

5. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to sell the Tractor House on land of Thomas Hunter for not less than \$500.00.

6. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to sell the land purchased from Edwin B. Edgerly for town dump.

7. To transact any other business which may legally come before said meeting.

FOREST FIRE WARDEN REPORT

Dear Mr. and Mrs. and Family :

Once again our region is covered with snow and the forest fire hazard has disappeared, but to your local forest fire warden it is just a time to check over his equipment and check the causes of the fires he has had. We know that our biggest cause of forest fires are careless people burning rubbish, brush or debris, without a permit or in a unsafe place. When this fire gets away from them and help is needed to put it out they then plead that they did not know a permit was required for the incinerator or this type burning. Well the old saying ignorance of the law is no excuse fits in here very well. The forest fire laws have been in the newspapers, on the radio, and on television and are on some posters, and there should be no excuses for not knowing a permit is required for all outdoor burning. In this year's report we are going to quote the law of the state of New Hampshire in regards to permits, this is found in Chapter 233—Section 35 revised laws, State of New Hampshire.

Permits

35b No person firm or corporation shall kindle or cause to be kindled any fire or shall burn or cause to be burned any material, and no city or town shall kindle or maintain a fire or a public dump in or near woodlands, pasture, brush, sprout, waste, or cutover land or where fire may be communicated to such lands, except when the ground is covered with snow, without first obtaining a written permit from the forest fire warden of the town where the burning is to be done unless the same is in the presence of the warden or his agent.

Liability for fires without permit.

36 Any person causing or kindling a fire without permit of the forest fire warden when such permit is required and any person by whose negligence or the negligence of his agents any fire shall be caused, shall be liable in a civil action for the payment to the town or the estate or both, of the expenses incurred by the forest fire warden or his deputy in attending or extinguishing such fire.

Penalties

38 Any person violating any provisions of section 35 shall be fined not more than two hundred dollars or imprisoned not more than sixty days.

YOUR FIRE DEPARTMENT

In view of the fact that few people in Tuftonboro are fully aware of the organization and function of the Tuftonboro Volunteer Fire Department, the following report might prove illuminating. The new structure of the Department includes in addition to the hundred or more Volunteers, a nucleus of 15 Active members who meet twenty times a year for the purpose of learning to use the equipment at hand to extinguish fires as well as the equally important methods of fire education and prevention.

Important also are the lessons learned at these training periods of life saving and casualty care. These 15 active members are: Walter Smith, Chief; Robert

Moulton, Secretary; Roger Davis, Delbert Haley, Jr., Clyde Bisbee, Kenneth Craigue, John Edgerly, Carlton Eldridge, Thomas Hunter, Norman Reed, Robert Straw, Thomas Mitchell, Richard Dore, Thomas Spencer, and Herman Stammers.

It is interesting to note that these Active members receive \$1.00 for each training period that they attend and if they miss more than 4 training periods in one year, they are automatically reduced to inactive status.

Much of the time is spent actually handling the hose, ladders, pumps, and other pieces of equipment so that their use becomes almost second nature.

In addition, meetings of verbal instruction are held, for instance, during the past year on several occasions, the training period has included a guest speaker or some person qualified to give instruction on some specialized subject. For instance, Chief Guy Foss of the Wolfeboro Department has been the guest of the active members on two occasions, and his talks on fire fighting technique are always interesting and educational. Bronson Garner has been present to give instruction and demonstrate new equipment that his company manufactures. At the Active meeting of March 20th, the Department was fortunate in having Captain McCallister of Laconia give a very informative demonstration of life saving methods. The highlight of which was his fine demonstration of the Schaeffer System of Artificial Respiration, at which all present were given individual instruction. Your Fire Department is extremely fortunate in owning one of the best resuscitators available. Each of the active members can operate this piece of equipment, which could possibly be a deciding factor between life and death in the case of an emergency.

Successfully, for the past two years, the Tuftonboro Fire Department has sponsored for the townspeople the program "Play For Your Life" a very educational

and entertaining evening featuring K. Thomas Call, whose demonstrations of fire hazards in the home, with the sometimes deadly results were impressively illustrated. Mr. Call's pleasant, congenial manner of presentation and clever slight of hand tricks always add up to an enjoyable evening of free entertainment. It is hoped that we will be able to get him to return this year, and that the hall will be filled to capacity.

Each year some of the Active members go to a fire fighting school for one day at Fitzwilliam, N. H. This school is sponsored by the Meadowbrook Fire Department and its training is available to all fire fighting units in N. H. The training program is reminiscent of the basic training methods used by the Armed Forces wherein a group is hustled from one class to another and at the end of the day, one's head seems to be ready to burst with the variety of things learned during the day and stored away for reference. Although the program covers a lot of ground in one day, each member attending retains some of the information acquired, and upon returning home, discussions are held during training meetings and by comparing each others notes, valuable lessons are learned.

At the moment of this writing, your Tuftonboro Volunteer Fire Department is awaiting the delivery of three portable radios and equipment that have been purchased through the results of the Annual Firemen's Ball and the generosity of the members of Bald Peak Colony Club, whose donations were received through the interest and untiring efforts of Col. Hugh Wilkin.

These units will increase the efficiency of your department in reaching fires, dispatching equipment, locating and reporting forest fires, and if the case necessitates, in summoning aid from Wolfeboro Department who will be operating on the same frequency.

All in all, your department has had a highly successful year of organization and administration, and it is

sincerely hoped that, as the Tuftonboro Volunteer Fire Department is owned by YOU, the taxpayer of Tuftonboro, that all will give it the support and help that it deserves. Remember too, that the prime function of every fire department is the **prevention** of fires, and the duty of every citizen to see that the basic rules of safety and fire prevention are practiced, and fire losses which cost you the taxpayer money will be held to a minimum.
