TOWN WARRANT

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Derry qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby instructed to meet at the Veterans Memorial Building, in said Town, on the second Tuesday of March next, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

By vote of the Selectmen, the polls for this meeting will remain open from ten o'clock in the forenoon until seventhirty o'clock in the afternoon, and as much longer thereafter as the Town, at the opening of the meeting, may vote.

- 1. To elect a Selectman for three years, Town Clerk, Treasurer, Collector of Taxes, Library Trustees, Trustees of the Trust Funds, Cemetery Trustee, Auditors and other necessary Town officials for the year ensuing.
- 2. To vote to raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for the maintenance of the poor, for laying out and repairing highways, for building and repairing bridges, for the suppression of moths, for police department and municipal court, for hydrant service and electric lights, for salaries of Town Officials, for the Board of Health, for the expense of the Town Hall, for support of the libraries, for State and County taxes, for the observance of Memorial Day, for aid to the Derry Visiting Nurse Association, for playground purposes and for band concerts, for co-operating with the State and Federal governments in the control of insect pests and white pine blister and for all necessary charges arising in said Town, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 3. To see if the Town will authorize its Selectmen to sell and convey any real estate acquired through deeds from the Collector of Taxes or as reimbursement for assistance furnished to citizens, and pass any vote relating thereto.

- 4. To see if the Town will authorize its Selectmen to incur debts for temporary loans in anticipation of taxes of the municipal year in which such debts are incurred and made payable therefrom, by such vote, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 5. To see if the Town will direct the Collector of Taxes to allow a discount to all persons paying their taxes within such period as the Town shall limit, to fix the rate of such discount, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 6. To see if the Town will vote to approve the recommendation of the Budget Committee that the sum of \$500.00 be taken from the income of the MacGregor Park Fund and expended during the summer of 1955 for band concerts at said MacGregor Park, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,200.61 for aid under apportionment A to match a State appropriation amounting to \$8,004.10 for the purpose of construction and reconstruction of Class 5 highways, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,740.00 for aid under apportionment B to match an appropriation by the State of \$3,740.00 for the purpose of construction and reconstruction of that portion of the Chester Road extending from the traffic circle at Derry Village to Nesmith Street, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 9. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to use the capital reserve funds in the hands of the Trustees of Trust Funds placed there for the definite purpose of establishing a public parking lot, and for this purpose to authorize the Selectmen to borrow, upon the notes of the Town issued in accordance with Chapter 258 of the Laws of 1953 entitled "Municipal Finance Act" a sum not in excess of \$2,000.00, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 10. To see if the Town wishes to adopt the recommendation of the Budget Committee that \$6,489.60 be transferred from parking meters receipts to the Police Department for

the purpose of patrolling the meters, and that the sum of \$2,400.00 from the parking meters receipts be transferred to the Highway Department for the purpose of cleaning about the meters, and that the balance of said receipts be transferred to the Trustees of the Trust Funds to be added to the Capital reserve fund for the purpose of grading, surfacing and improving the public parking lots leased and owned by the Town, and pass any vote relating thereto.

- 11. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the unexpended balance of sewer maintenance funds to the capital reserve funds held by the Trustees of Trust Funds as a sewer construction fund, plus any revenues in addition to those anticipated in the budget, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5,000.00 to be added to the capital reserve fund established for the purpose of construction of a sewer and disposal plant for the Town, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 13. To see if the Town will authorize its Selectmen to sell and convey the interest of the Town in the real estate situated on the westerly side of the Londonderry Turnpike, known as the Gage land, the portion situated in the Town of Derry being described in deed of Matthew Gage to Daniel Gage, dated November 3, 1886 and recorded in the Rockingham County Registry of Deeds in Volume 506, Page 267, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 14. To see if the Town will vote to authorize its Selectmen to petition the Superior Court to release the real estate situated on the easterly side of Birch Street in Derry from the restrictions placed on it under the terms of the will of Harrison Alexander, and request the court to allow a deviation from the terms in said will so that said real estate may be sold and the proceeds used for a purpose as nearly as possible like the purpose set forth in said will, it being generally recognized in Derry that said parcel of real estate is not suitable for the purpose of a town playground, that there is urgent need for building sites close to the center of the town,

and that said Alexander land is suitable for housing purposes, and further authorize its Selectmen to sell and convey said Alexander land in the event that a decree of the Superior Court authorizes said sale.

- 15. By petition, to see if the Town will vote to:
- (a) Place a fire hydrant somewhere on that part of Town known as Franklin Terrace.
- (b) Place a fire hydrant somewhere on that part of Town known as Franklin Terrace and more particularly at the corner of Concord Avenue and Exeter Street, on said Franklin Terrace.
- (c) Appropriate the necessary funds for the placing of said fire hydrant on Franklin Terrace, in the event such a vote is necessary to carry out clause (a) or clause (b) of this petition.
- 16. By petition, to see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 for Little League in Derry.
- 17. By petition, to see if the Town will vote to authorize and direct that the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) appropriated at the Annual Town Meeting held March 12, 1946, for the purpose of piping and installing a fire hydrant at the Elms Corner in East Derry, be now applied, together with the accumulated interest thereon, for the construction of a suitable water hole in the East Derry Fire District, this being most advantageous for the interests and protection of the Alexander-Eastman Hospital, and pass any vote relating thereto.
 - 18. By petition, to see if the Town will vote to:
- (a) Remove present location of sand pit and sand shed to a less conspicuous site.
- (b) Install street drains on Fordway between numbers 33 and 35, also on Brook Street in front of the Carey residence.
- (c) Seek installation of stop sign at junction of Brook Street and Fordway Road.
- (d) Remedy the condition of pavement at the junction of Brook Street and Fordway Road.

- 19. To see if the Town will ratify and confirm the action of the annual meeting of 1954 and reauthorize the Selectmen to borrow, upon the negotiable notes of the Town issued in accordance with Chapter 258 of the Laws of 1953 entitled "Municipal Finance Act" a sum not exceeding \$23,000.00 for the purpose of paying the balance of the Town's share for rebuilding that section of the Chester Road extending from the traffic circle in Derry Village to Nesmith Street, said notes to be repaid in five equal, annual installments, and pass any vote relating thereto, no notes having been issued under the 1954 vote.
- 20. To hear the reports of agents, auditors and committees heretofore chosen, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 21. To appoint any necessary committees on any article embraced in this warrant.
- 22. To transact any other business that may lawfully come before such meeting.

DERRY PUBLIC LIBRARY Derry, N. H.

The 50the annual report is herewith presented:

The Derry Public Library opened its doors to the public 50 years ago in the Adams Memorial Building. Many changes have taken place during these years of service. It began its service to the public with 1200 books. The circulation for the first 6 months was nearly 10,000 and over 900 cards were issued to the public. Today we have 16,443 volumes and a circulation for a 6 month period of 12,500 books.

Many changes and improvements have taken place during the past 50 years. The library soon outgrew its quarters in the Adams Memorial building. The will of the late Henry Mc-Gregor made it possible to have a building of its own. This has made for more and better service to the public.

This year we felt it necessary to have a larger children's room. After much planning of space and equipment we moved the children into the larger room. The smaller room was then turned into a cozy reading room for adults. This has proved a very worthwhile venture. Now there is no crowding but plenty of room for all.

The reference room is well used. Every day finds many students using the material made available to them from the reference shelves. Many books from the stacks are used to help them in their search for extra material for their school projects.

We have had many gifts of books. Some have already been cataloged and are on the shelves. Others will be made available as fast as possible. We wish to thank those who have given us these books during the past year. We also wish to thank the Arts and Crafts members who made it possible to have such a fine table lamp for the reading room.

A display of books and posters were shown at the Grinnell School fair. This gave the parents and teachers a good chance to see some of the recent additions to the children's room.

Most of the books discarded this year were from the basement shelves. Many of these books have been downstairs for years and very much outdated material. We felt the shelf

room was much more valuable to us than the old books. They were sold as old paper.

Another change was made during the summer. This was eliminating all 7 day books. Also all books are dated the "due date" rather than "issue date," and the new method is less confusing to the patrons.

REPORT OF TRUSTEES

The service of the library to the community has continued as usual. The facilities have been used for small group meetings as well as serving the usual library functions. The staff renders courteous and efficient service. The correlation with services at state level makes it possible to have available any book desired. This is a valuable service for research problems for students and the regular patrons of the library.

A change in the location of the reading room for children has improved the facilities for both adults and children.

The same staff has continued to serve the reading public. The prompt, courteous, efficient service of these employees of the library has resulted in a high level of library use.

The staff and the trustees, however, urge that all use the facilities more frequently.

There seems to be some misunderstanding and misinformation in the community as to the finances at the library. Over the past five years the trustees have with a small increase in the repairs item increased the cash balance at the end of the year so that they might, without a special appropriation, change the boiler which has been in service since the opening of the library. In order that there may be no question as to the accuracy of this statement the financial report of the past four years are reproduced. The cash balance now is at a level that will permit the replacement of the boiler in 1955.

It is hoped that this will clear up some of the misstatements of the past town meeting.
