## TOWN WARRANT

### THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of Center Harbor qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town House, in said town, on the second Tuesday of March next, at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary town officers.
2. To see how much money the town will vote to raise for current expenses.
3. To see if the town will vote to elect one or more road agents or instruct the selectmen to appoint an expert highway agent.
4. To see how much money the town will vote to raise for repairs of highways and bridges.
5. To see how much money the town will vote to raise for maintenance of trunk lines in the town.
6. To see how much money the town will vote to raise for maintenance of State Aid roads in the town.
7. To see if the town will vote to accept State Aid for improvement of highways, raise money for same, and if so, how much.
8. To see if the town will vote to raise money on town debt, and if so, how much.

9. To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to hire money for town purposes in anticipation of taxes.

10. To see if the town will vote to raise money to defray the expenses of Memorial Day, and if so, how much.

11. To see if the town will vote to raise money to defray the expenses of electric lights in Center Harbor village, and if so, how much.

12. To see if the town will choose an agent to care for the fountain at Center Harbor Village.

13. To see if the town will choose an agent or agents to care for cemeteries throughout the town.

14. To see if the town will vote to raise money for the Fire Station, and if so, how much.

15. To see if the town will choose a committee to take charge of wharf and make regulations for the same.

16. To see if the town will vote to raise money for aid to the Laconia Hospital, and if so, how much.

17. To see if the town will vote to raise money for a snow fence, and if so, how much.

18. To see if the town will vote to raise money for the improvement of the road from Hawkins Bridge, so called, to the foot of Piper Hill, and if so, how much.

19. To see if the town will vote to raise money to pay one half the expense of building a cement sidewalk on the Bean Road, so called, from the Whittier Highway to Kelsea Avenue. (By petition).

20. To see if the town will vote to raise money for the improvement of the road from Town House to Waukewan Bridge, so called, and if so, how much.

21. To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of four hundred dollars for the extermination of White Pine Blister Rust.

22. To choose agents and committees in relation to any article in this warrant and hear reports of any heretofore chosen.



To the Tax Payers and Citizens of Center Harbor:

It is very pleasing to be able to report another year of successful school administration, as the report of Supt. Small will show, and to which we invite your careful attention.

Your Board has held meetings every month during the school year, receiving reports from Supt. Small, which have had our careful attention. In the Village School the primary room proved too small for the increase in pupils. We have enlarged same adding 12 feet and changing the windows to admit more light and sunshine, and putting on new screens at all windows as well as heavy screen doors, at a cost of \$981.78 by close economy. We were able to do all these repairs without an extra appropriation. We think we have two as good school houses now as most towns the size of ours can boast of.

Your Board is not satisfied with the Town House school building. There is no play ground for the pupils except in the road and the building is of little value, and we hope ere long to make some radical change there. It is very hard to know how to handle this school to the best advantage owing to so many changes in the number of pupils. We are always open for suggestions.

The Board desires to urge the parents to visit the schools more often, and to become better acquainted with the school work.
