TOWN WARRANT

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of Center Harbor qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town House, in said town, on the second Tuesday of March next, at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary town officers.

2. To see how much money the town will vote to raise for current expenses.

3. To see if the town will vote to elect one or more road agents or instruct the selectmen to appoint an expert highway agent.

4. To see how much money the town will vote to raise for repairs of highways and bridges.

5. To see if the town will vote to raise money for the maintenance of Trunk Line highway, and if so, how much.

6. To see if the town will vote to raise money, and if so, how much, to resurface the remainder of D. W. highway in Center Harbor.

7. To see if the town will vote to raise money, and if so, how much, for the purpose of buying pump, hose, and any other needed equipment for fire protection.

8. To see if the town will authorize the selectmen to sell the machinery bought by the town, at the tax sale of the Albert O. Smith property. 9. To see how much money the town will vote to raise for maintenance of State Aid roads in the town.

10. To see if the town will vote to accept State Aid for improvement of highways, raise money for same, and if so, how much.

11. To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to hire money for town purposes in anticipation of taxes.

12. To see if the town will vote to raise money to defray expenses of Memorial Day, and if so, how much.

13. To see if the town will vote to raise money to defray the expenses of electric lights in Center Harbor village, if so, how much.

14. To see if the town will choose an agent to care for the fountain at the Center Harbor village.

15. To see if the town will choose an agent or agents to care for cemeteries throughout the town.

16. To see if the town will vote to raise money for care and fuel for Fire Station, and if so, how much.

17. To see if the town will choose a committee to take charge of wharf and make regulations for the same.

18. To see if the town will vote to raise money for aid to the Laconia Hospital, and if so, how much.

19. To see if the town will vote to raise money, and if so, how much, for the improvement of the highway from Thompson Corner, so called, past the Wister place to Holderness town line.

20. To see if the town will vote to hire or buy a tractor for the purpose of breaking roads.

21. To see if the town will vote to raise money, and if so, how much, for the improvement of the road from Town House to Waukewan Bridge, so called.

22. To see if the town will raise money for the improvement of Kelsea Avenue, and if so, how much.

23. To see if the town will take the necessary steps for the removal of the old delapidated mill at the entrance of West Center Harbor.

24. To see if the town will authorize the renewal of guide boards throughout the town.

25. To see if the town will vote to wire the Town House for electricity, raise money for the same, and if so, how much.

26. To see if the town will vote to raise money to be applied on the town debts, and if so, how much.

27. To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of four hundred dollars for the extermination of White Pine Blister Rust.

28. To choose agents and committees in relation to any article in this warrant and hear reports of any heretofore chosen.

Health is, of course, of primary importance, and sick children should not be in school.

Irregular attendance is very closely related to poor scholarship. It is also frequently an index of home conditions. It may reveal poor teaching or other unsatisfactory school conditions.

At the village school many of the tardy marks are due to the fact that the children were taking music lessons. This has been permitted by the School Board as it desires to aid in every reasonable way parents and pupils in their efforts toward improvement.
