Written by American poet Grace Ellery Channing towards the end of World War I, "Any Woman to a Soldier" takes the perspective of a woman addressing a man who is leaving to fight in the war. American writer and educator Brander Matthews selected the poem for inclusion in his 1922 anthology *Poems of American Patriotism*, which was dedicated to the memory of American president Theodore Roosevelt, who had died three years prior.
