

Dear Larry:

This letter accompanies the last of the materials I was to deliver to the Scientology organization pursuant to the December 1986 settlement agreements.

If there were more papers of mine stored in Oregon, which is where the enclosed documents have been since 1985, they were included in what Garry McMurry has delivered to organization representatives since the settlement. I have no present recollection in any case of what even generally the documents might have been, if indeed they ever existed; however I know that anything I would have left in Oregon storage was benign, innocuous or literarily unappealing since I shipped everthing nasty, useful or belletristic to Boston when I began working with Flynn & Joyce. I mention all this because I had told Roger Geller, I believe, that there was possibly as much as a box of my materials to be retrieved from Portland.
