DECLARATION OF LYNN FARNY

I, LYNN FARNY, declare:

1. I am a staff member and minister of the Church of Scientology of California and have been a staff member of the Church of Scientology of California for approximately 3 1/2 years. This declaration is offered in support of Plantiff's application for reconsideration of its application for issuance of a temporary restraining order. I am competent to testify to the facts set forth herein and would so testify if called as a witness.

12 2. The subject of this declaration is to provide clarification of exactly what it means within the 13 Church of Scientology to be declared a 14 Suppressive Person, I am qualified to provide 15 this clarification as I am well trained in Scientology Ethics and Justice policies and, in 16 my present position within the Church, I am 17 responsible for the administration of these 18 policies within the United States Guardian Office. 19

3. A Scientologist is declared a Suppressive 21 Person when his actions have intentionally resulted in destruction. The declaration is, 22 actually, a statement of the current spiritual 23 condition of the person, wherein he not only does 24 not wish any spiritual betterment in himself, he 25 is actively preventing the spiritual betterment of his fellows; all as evidenced by his 26 destructive actions. Earlier attempts to assist 27 the person toward a path of spiritual enlightenment having been to no avail. 28

4. A person so declared, is no londer a member in dood standing of the Church of Scientology and cannot again become a member in dood standing until the person ceases his destructive actions and becomes desirous of spiritual betterment and can demonstrate, by his actions, that he no longer seeks to prevent the spiritual betterment of himself and his fellows.

5. Should a person who has been declared a Suppressive Ferson feel that this declaration is false, he does have recourse. He may petition for a hearing before an impartial Committee of fellow Scientologists who will weigh the facts of the matter and come to a decision as to whether, or not the Suppressive Person declare was warrented. The Committee will either absolve the person, or let the Suppressive Person declare stand, depending upon the evidence.

6. A person who has been declared a Suppressive Ferson has the option of seeking corrective measures that will assist him to reach a level of spiritual awareness where he realizes that he has been destructive to himself and his fellows. Once the person does this, he is, again, a member of the Church of Scientology in good standing.

7. The person is given ample opportunity to persue these corrective measures. Should it become obvious that the person has no intention of doing so, then he is expelled from the Church of Scientology and the Church has nothing further to do with the person.

8. One of the basic tenents of Scientology is that man is basically good. This applies to even

those persons who have been expelled. Therefore, the Church always leaves the door to spiritual enlightenment open. Should the person who has been expelled from the Church, at some future time, recant and sincerely wish to persue a path of spiritual enlightenment, the person will be given an opportunity to be restored to membership in good standing in the Church.

9, Once a person has been declared a Suppressive 8 Person and expelled from the Church of 9 Scientology and prior to any origination from the 10 person that her again, desires to persue a path of spiritual enlightenment and betterment, the 11 Church originates no dealings with the person. 12 What the person does with his life once expelled 13 is of absolutely no concern to the Church. While on a spiritual level it is always hoped that the 14 person will at some point in the future "return 15 to the fold', as it were, the Church takes no 16 action to precipitate that decision, nor to dissuade the person from the path he has chosen 17 for himself. 18

19 10. As in all cases with declares of Suppressive 20 Fersons, there has been no action, or harassment 21 directed at Gerry Armstrong, as a result of his declare.

23 I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth above and an competent to personally testify thereto.
