DECLARATION OF GERALD ARMSTRONG

I, Gerald Armstrong, declare:

1. I am making this declaration in response to allegations made by Scientology and its attorneys Donald C. Randolph and John G. Peterson regarding "violations" of various Court orders.

2. On page 8 of Scientology's motion are listed five (5) documents which the organization claims were sealed documents used by the Justice Department in violation of this Court's sealing orders: Defendants trial exhibits HHHH, EEE, K, and MM, and Plaintiff's trial exhibit 47. None of these documents were "sealed documents".

3. Defendant's exhibit HHHH, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is the "Mission Order" of Plaintiff organization to prevent Homer Schomer from testifying at my trial. The organization's missionaries left it in Mr. Schomer's home. Mr. Schomer copied it for himself and brought it to the trial where several copies were made. My attorney marked HHHH on a copy and introduced it into evidence through Mr. Schomer. A copy was given to Plaintiff's attorneys. The document was not sealed by the Court; but even if it were, copies were in the possession of several third parties, and a sealing order would be meaningless, as is Plaintiff organization's contention that a violation of a "sealing order" exists.

4. Defendant's exhibit EEE, attached hereto as Exhibit "B", is a copy of Plaintiff organization's "CIC Cross Mark Sheet" indicating the cross-filing of intelligence data concerning Attorney Michael Flynn. This document had been produced

1 by the organization in a Federal Court case in Tampa, Florida,
2 McLean v. Church of Scientology, Case No. 81-174-CIV - T - K.
3 My attorneys had copies long before the Armstrong trial. One
4 of these was copied and admitted into evidence. The fact that
5 the same document, exhibit 5 to Plaintiff organization's motion,
6 does not have the Court's exhibit sticker and number, but just
7 my attorney's handwritten notation, made after the Court as-
8 signed the exhibit number, shows where the document came from,
9 and just how hollow the organization's claim of a violation of
10 the "sealing order" is. This was never a "sealed document."

11 5. Defendant's exhibit K, attached hereto as Exhi-
12 bit "C", is a Flag Order entitled "Commodore's Messengers"
13 written by L. Ron Hubbard. This document was first submitted
14 as an exhibit to a declaration written by me and filed in this
15 case in September 1982. Plaintiff organization did not seek
16 to have it sealed then, nor several times thereafter when I used
17 it as an exhibit in this case and in other jurisdictions. This
18 document could not have been sealed by the Court. It is a public
19 document.

20 6. Defendant's exhibit MM, attached hereto as Exhi-
21 bit "D", is a "Declaration of Religious Commitment" for the
22 Church of Scientology International. As with Exhibit "C", this
23 document has been appended to several declarations I have filed
24 in this case as early as September 1982. It has been distri-
25 buted broadly since. It was never included in any sealing
26 order.

27 7. Plaintiff's exhibit 47, attached hereto as Exhi-
28 bit "E", is an organization Policy Letter entitled "Understanding

1 Corporate Integrity." It was never a "sealed document." As can
2 be seen by the document's routing, it was given to all Sciento-
3 logy staff members in every organization. Plaintiff's attorneys
4 handed a copy to my attorney during the trial, and my attorney
5 marked the document with the number assigned to it by the Court.
6 Following the trial, the various exhibits which had been admitted
7 into evidence, not sealed, and of which I had a copy, were copied
8 and given by me to anyone who requested them. This document has
9 never been sealed and any sealing order would be senseless.

10 8. At p. 8 n. 3 of Plaintiff organization's motion
11 is the statement that Exhibit I to the Department of Justice's
12 Motion to Dismiss of September 1984 (see Plaintiff's exhibit 6)
13 was also used by the government in violation of the Court's seal-
14 ing order. The further claim is made that this document en-
15 titled "Operation Bulldozer Leak", the purpose of which was
16 "To effectively spread the rumor that will lead government,
17 media and individual SPs to conclude that LRH has no control of
18 the Church of Scientology and no Legal Liability for Church
19 activity", has on it "the handwritten Armstrong trial exhibit
20 number." This document has a lot of handwritten numbers on it,
21 but none are from Armstrong, because this document was never
22 a trial exhibit , either for Defendant or Plaintiff, and
23 was never a "sealed document".

24 9. Attached hereto as Exhibits "F" and "G" are two (2)
25 documents entitled respectively "Archives Trust" and "Success
26 Story RPF Completion." In the Armstrong trial, these were
27 respectively Plaintiff's exhibits 28 and 53. These same docu-
28 ments were introduced ^{by} /the same organization as Defense exhibits

1 numbers 884 and 890 during my cross-examination in the Case of
2 Christofferson v. Scientology, et al, No. A7704-05184 in the
3 Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Multnomth
4 in April 1985. Clearly, the Scientology organization must be by
5 its standard in violation of the same mythological sealing order.

6 10. Included among Plaintiff's and Defendant's trial
7 exhibits were several books: Phoenix Lectures, Introduction to
8 Scientology Ethics, All About Radiation, Dianetics, the Original
9 Thesis, Technical Dictionary, Background and Ceremonies. If, as
10 Plaintiff organization seems to be contending, the "sealing
11 order" is a blanket order covering not just the actual sealed
12 documents, but all trial exhibits regardless of their source,
13 these books should also be covered by such an order. Yet a
14 check on this date has revealed that Plaintiff organization has
15 these books for sale to the public in its bookstores. This is
16 absurd, of course, but so is the organization's construing of
17 the facts in this motion now before the Court.

18 11. Regarding the MCCS tapes, I have no personal know-
19 ledge how the transcript came into the possession of the IRS. I
20 obtained the tapes, transcribed them, and prepared an affidavit
21 from them exactly as I have described in earlier declarations
22 and testimony. In my opinion, they evidence a continuing fraud
23 being perpetrated by L. Ron Hubbard, the organization, and
24 various attorneys. I definitely sent the transcript to Omar
25 Garrison who was interested for the biography in how Hubbard
26 was able to extract funds from Scientology, and I believe I sent
27 a copy to my attorney, Michael Flynn. As the organization
28 has had the transcript since at least the summer of 1983

1 when Omar Garrison delivered to Hubbard's representatives
2 the materials he had for the biography project, any of the
3 people with access to these materials could have sent the
4 transcript to the IRS.

5 I declare under the penalty of perjury under
6 the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is
7 true and correct.

COMMODORE'S MESSENGERS

A Commodore's Messenger carrying an order or running a project or otherwise on duty is an emissary of the Commodore.

What is said or done to that Messenger by staff or persons receiving the Messenger's orders is being said or done to the Commodore.

The Messenger's handlings of such statements must be what the Commodore would say or do in such circumstances.

If the Messenger does not handle as above, the Commodore's own authority is undermined and the area will go out of control.

The Beingness of a Commodore's Messenger on duty is an emissary of the Commodore. What is done or said to that Messenger is being said or done to the Commodore.

The orders the Messenger issues may be those directly from the Commodore or indirectly as a result of the duty being performed by, or the area of assigned responsibility of the Messenger, and even when the idea of the Messenger.

Thus it follows that a Messenger must have some idea of what the Commodore would do and DO IT in response to any statements or actions by the person or persons receiving such a message or order.

A Messenger operating on his own operations or judgments on duty and issuing orders on these is still an emissary of the Commodore and such opinions or judgements must not be defied and are considered as above.

A Messenger has never been disciplined or even scolded for operating as above.

There are two types of goofs. Those between the Messenger and the Commodore and those between the Messenger and an area. The former does get handled by the Commodore. The latter, never.

What a Messenger may miss is that the people they are talking to DO consider the Messenger to be my personal emissary.

To do other than the above can destroy an org or area.

8. (a) I am not a blown staff member or blown Sea Organization member. (b) I have in the past blown, as described above, but have since recanted and been given forgiveness and accepted back into the Church after having made proper restitution. _____

EXHIBIT "D"

GLOSSARY

CHARTER	A written grant by a national or state government to a colony, a group of citizens, a university, a commercial company, etc., bestowing the right of organization, with other privileges, and specifying the form of organization.
COMMUNITY	A number of people having common ties or interests living in the same place and subject to the same laws.
CORPORATE	<u>adj.</u> belonging to a corporation; having to do with a corporation.
CORPORATION	A group of persons who obtain a charter giving them as a group certain legal rights and privileges distinct from those of the individual members of the group. A corporation can buy and sell, own property, etc., as if its members were a single person.
DOCTRINAL	<u>adj.</u> of or having to do with doctrine.
DOCTRINE	What is taught as the belief of a church or group of persons; belief, principle; what is taught, teachings.
FRATERNAL	<u>adj.</u> of or characteristic of a brother or brothers; of or like a fraternal order.
FRATERNAL ORDER	A group organized for mutual aid and fellowship.
INCORPORATE	To form into a legal corporation.
INCORPORATION	An act of incorporating or the state of being incorporated.
INTEGRITY	Integrity comes from a latin word meaning untouched, whole, entire. It is now defined as 1. honesty, uprightness; 2. quality or state of being complete, wholeness; 3. undivided or unbroken condition; 4. perfect condition.
THEOLOGICAL	<u>adj.</u> of, having to do with or dealing with theology.
THEOLOGY	The study of god; the study of religion and religious beliefs; a system of religious beliefs.

10. I do not have a parent or a guardian who is a rabid antagonist of Scientology.
11. I am not here to obtain news stories or data for any other organization or to generally disrupt the Church.
12. I do not have personal debts of a magnitude such that efforts to satisfy them would immediately disrupt or cause me to pull back from my commitment to the Church.
13. I do not have any mental institutional history, by which is meant incarceration or voluntary stay in a mental institution and knowingly or unknowingly receiving treatment therein.
14. I have had no prior service in a high security section of the government or armed forces.
15. I am married (), unmarried ().
16. My spouse has no objection to my working for the Church.
17. I am not currently on drugs.

(Exception to any of the above points can be made only after an applicant has petitioned a Senior Officer of the Church and received unconditional acceptance. Such written approval must be presented to HCO before signing the Contract.)

I hereby state that to the best of my knowledge I have honestly made the declarations above at points 1 to 17. I accept and agree that any false statement by me will disqualify me from becoming or remaining an active participating staff member and may subject me to any Church justice procedures and/or legal proceedings as may be appropriate or necessary pursuant to the policies of the Church and/or the laws of the land.

CONDITIONS:

I understand and agree that the following conditions are based on the fact that the Church staff members are members of a religious order and serve pursuant to their religious obligations.

I realize that my signature on this covenant and the acceptance of same binds me to follow the administrative, ecclesiastical, moral and ethical policies, rules, norms and practices of the Church of Scientology INTERNATIONAL as a member of a religious order.

and I recognize and understand that neither Ron nor Mary Sue Hubbard receive any compensation or remuneration from training or processing by the Church, that neither Ron nor Mary Sue Hubbard are officers or directors of the Church and that neither of them are in any manner responsible for actions of the Church. Further, I recognize, understand, and agree that in consideration for the Church permitting me to become an active participant pursuant to this Declaration, I shall not commence any action or assert any claim against either or both of them, their heirs, successors, or assigns, based on any matter arising out of or in connection with the Church, and I hereby release L. Ron Hubbard and Mary Sue Hubbard, and their heirs, successors and assigns, from and against any and all claims or causes of action of every nature and sort which I or my successors or assigns ever had, now have, or may hereafter acquire, arising out of my dealings with the Church as a staff member pursuant to this Declaration. I expressly waive the provisions of California Civil Code Section 1542, which provides: "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favour at the time of executing the release, which if known by him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor."

| 1. Service Hours and Extra Service. | The Day Organization serves weekdays, the Foundation serves evenings and weekends. Staff are expected to study in their off duty hours and to assist with additional duties. The Sea Organization schedule is as laid out by individual Sea Organization groups and units. |
| 2. Holidays. | 2 service weeks per year after one year's service, for Class IV org staff and 3 weeks per year for Sea Org Members. |
| 3. Sick Leave. | 2 days non-accumulative in every calendar month, upon presentation of a doctor's certificate. |
| 4. Pension. | The Church does not provide a pension or any other retirement program. |

5. **Furnishing of Necessaries.** Church Staff Members serve pursuant to religious commitment and conviction rather than for monetary gain or other traditional commercial or financial motives or incentives. Nevertheless, the Church will, pursuant to this covenant, furnish certain necessities, including a weekly allowance, and for certain staff positions, room and board. The furnishing of these necessary items is not intended to be and is not compensation for services performed by the applicant, but rather it provides an opportunity for the Church to establish an appropriate environment within which religious and spiritual awareness may receive the greatest prospect for enhancement and in which such matters constitute the reward for services. The amount of weekly allowance may vary depending upon economic conditions generally prevailing within the Church.
6. **Policy.** Staff are subject to existing policy (subject to amendment or addition). Staff study and receive examination on their knowledge of Policies, Bulletins and Directives relating to their activities and upon other Policies, Bulletins and Directives as from time to time requested.
7. **Staff Activities.** Staff members shall accept whatever activity is assigned, in accordance with existing policy.
8. **Status.** Temporary or Provisional staff may be dismissed in accordance with HCO Policy Letter 4 Jan 1966R Issue V, PERSONNEL STAFF STATUS (copy of which may be viewed on request).

Permanent staff are also subject to this policy.
9. **Membership.** Newly joined staff are deemed to be Scientology staff members in good standing. Persons who have been found to be no longer Scientology staff members in good standing by properly constituted Church authority are not eligible to remain on staff.
10. **Duration of Covenant.** 2½ year and 5 year periods of staff service are governed by this Covenant as well as staff service on a weekly basis.
11. **Benefits.** Church staff members are eligible for such benefits or privileges as may, from time to time, be issued in HCO PL form as they apply to staff members.

12. Breach of Covenant
- An active participant of the Church, having forsaken traditional commercial and financial motivations and concerns, by making this religious declaration, and who receives (as per para 11 above) services at no cost or 50% of costs shall, if he breaks his agreement either by leaving staff before completing his covenant or by violating his good standing as a Scientology staff member so that he is dismissed in accordance with policy, remit forthwith to the Church a sum as figured per HCOPL 11 June 1981, Violation of Staff Covenant if such person is declared a "freeloader". This provision is not intended to reflect traditional commercial bargains or concerns, is not intended to operate as a civil penalty, and is intended as a manifestation of applicable ecclesiastical ethics and as a provision for liquidating damages.
13. Ethical Conduct
- As members of a religious order, Church staff members are expected to uphold a high degree of ethical conduct in accordance with Church policy and doctrine. Church staff members are governed by the ethics policies of the Church which are designed to assist a person to become a more ethical, productive and happy being. A person who continually violates the ethical codes of the Church despite attempts by the Church to help him/her get ethics in may, if he/she honestly seeks redemption, be assigned to a REHABILITATION PROJECT FORCE as a means to raise his/her ethical standards to a point where he/she can again participate and exchange in an ethical environment in accordance with Church doctrine. Such an assignment is made and carried out in the spirit of helping the Church staff member as mentioned above.
14. Sea Organization
- The terms and conditions of the Covenant shall apply should the staff member join the Sea Organization except and unless as specifically amended in writing.
15. Entirety of Covenant
- The Church shall not be obligated to honor any verbal promises or any other terms or conditions not specifically covered in this Covenant. This Covenant forms the entirety of the Church's agreement with the Church staff member, and promises no specific counselling, training, posts or other favors to any Church staff member.

I have read and understand this Covenant in its entirety. I realize that this Covenant forms the entirety of the Church's agreement with myself as specified in point 15 of the Conditions herein. I am joining staff and becoming a member of a religious order solely to help forward the religious goals and tenets of the Church of Scientology INTERNATIONAL and not for monetary gain, auditing or training.

With full knowledge of the information supplied, and being fully aware of the conditions stated in the Covenant, I agree to become a staff member of the Church of Scientology INTERNATIONAL for a period of (a) 5 years ;

~~(c) on a weekly basis,~~

and sign as follows:

UNDERSTANDING CORPORATE INTEGRITY

NOTE: This Policy Letter is drawn verbatim from the text of a booklet under the same title. For convenience various terms, each marked with an asterisk, have been defined in a Glossary appended to this Policy Letter.

UNDERSTANDING CORPORATE INTEGRITY

("Policy: Corporate structures must be correct legal and valid." (LRH).)

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT FOR A STAFF MEMBER TO UNDERSTAND CORPORATE INTEGRITY?

Responsible leadership and participation on the third dynamic requires a thorough knowledge of the relationship of one's group to the rest of the society. This relationship takes on many forms such as economic exchange, public relations and legal. Corporate Integrity is a principal part of the legal relationship.

WHY IN PARTICULAR IS THE LEGAL RELATIONSHIP IMPORTANT?

Answering this question goes back to a fundamental.

As L. Ron Hubbard has frequently pointed out, all power stems from a stable terminal. In HCO PL 29 July 1971 "Why Hatting" he states:

"In Scientology 8-80 the base of the motor is discussed. It holds two terminals in fixed positions. Because they are so fixed, power can be generated.

"If a thetan can hold a position or location in space he can generate POWER."

This principle extends and applies fully to organizations. In our Society at this time the corporate integrity of a company or Church is the base of its legality, of its power. Only from a sound legal foundation can an organization safely expand in today's world.

This has been true for ages. Before the current pattern of legal incorporation, royal charters were required, and before that the agreement of the tribal elders. The third dynamic is that way.

For this reason HCO PL 11 December 1961 by L. Ron Hubbard gives as Org Rudiment 1:

HOW IS THE RELIGION SCIENTOLOGY LEGALLY INCORPORATED?

As a Church. The first incorporation of a Church of Scientology as such was on 18th February 1954, only four years after the publication of Book One.

IS THERE ONLY ONE CHURCH OF SCIENTOLOGY?

No, there are many around the world. These Churches are separately incorporated. For example, each US Church is a separate and distinct corporate entity, incorporated in the various States where they operate as a non-profit religious corporation.

Although Scientology Churches are legally independent they are united by a theological bond of common faith. For example, theologically the senior church in the United States is the Church of Scientology of California. This in no way gives legal jurisdiction of the C of S of C over other Churches, as they are separate corporations, but the other Churches do, of course, respond to the advice and guidance of their theological senior.

WHAT ABOUT, FOR INSTANCE, AOLA AND ASHO OR A FOLO LIKE FOLO WUS?

AOLA and ASHO were started by the C of S of C. They have always been and are part of the C of S of Calif, US. Similarly FOLO WUS was formed by and is an integral part of the C of S of Calif.

Other AOs and SHs and FOLOs are each part of a Church in the country in which they are situated.

WHAT ABOUT THE TERM "SEA ORG ORGS"?

This term is a misnomer which derives from a confusion concerning the relationship of the Sea Org to the Church.

It was sometimes used to describe churches where a majority of Sea Org members were employed or which were first established by Sea Org members employed by the Church.

There are of course no "Sea Org Orgs". All Scientology orgs operate under the name of the existing religious corporation, e.g. The Founding Church of Scientology of Washington, D.C., Church of Scientology of Nevada, etc.

The term is misleading and incorrect and has been discarded from terminology.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I HEAR THE TERM BEING USED?

Indicate to the user that it is improper usage and refer him to this policy letter.

WHAT IS THE SEA ORG?

The Sea Organization is a fraternal^m organization existing within the formalized structure of the Churches of Scientology. It consists of highly dedicated members of the Church. These members take vows of eternal service. The Sea Organization life style of community living is traditional to religious orders.

The Sea Organization has no corporate structure or identity. The leadership of the Sea Org is found within the Church of Scientology of California (Flag Bureaux). Sea Org members work for the various independent Churches of Scientology. The individual Sea Org member would be an employee of whatever Church worked for, and is subject as are all other employees of that Church to the Board of Directors.

The Sea Org exists as the Sea Org to raise the ability to confront and handle MEST. It was founded as an OT organization and continues to be one. The case level and confront level of its members, its speed of particle flow, its multiple viewpoint system are all hallmarks of an OT organization.

Its members are bound together by the highest standards of ethical conduct and personal contribution, which are summarized in the Code of a Sea Org Member.

The Sea Organization is also organized with titles and ranks.

The insignia of the Sea Org are trademarked in the name of the Church of Scientology of California.

In essence, membership in the Sea Organization is an additional honor which a Scientologist may select, but in no way affects the running of the Churches except where Sea Org members are employed in executive capacities by churches.

It is noted however, due to the strenuous training and higher confront levels of Sea Org members that churches employing a majority of Sea Org members have a higher efficiency and production ratio per staff member than otherwise.

WHAT IS FLAG?

The Church of Scientology of California operates a Marine Mission aboard a chartered vessel. This Marine Mission is commonly referred to as Flag. It is operated under the aegis (protection, support) of the Church of Scientology of California, as are the other facilities of the Church (AO-ASHO).

There is and must be a central area where the standard of Scientology administration and technology are maintained through training and counselling as well as management consultation and advices. A central point is also needed for the codification of various Church dissemination and educational materials and their release. Flag fulfills these needs for all Churches. It in no way has "legal" authority over Scientology Churches, but is looked to for doctrinal^m and ethical authority.

HAS ANYTHING CHANGED?

No, nothing has been changed. But due to confusion which may have developed over the years in some people's minds, it has become advisable to reassert in correct form what already exists in legal structures. These are the traditional relationships existing between these various identities.

No Policy Letters or Flag Orders, lines or terminals have been changed. Only the traditional legal relationships have been reconfirmed in such a way as to give more direction and power into the hands of Scientologists and Sea Org members without impairing forward progress but expanding it.
