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DECLARATION OF GERALD ARMSTRONG

I, Gerald Armstrong, declare:

- 1. I have received from plaintiff Scientology organization a copy of what they have called my "B-1" or GO intelligence file. It consists of 623 pages of documents, essentially what was produced as my B-1 file in the case of Christofferson v. Scientology in Portland, Oregon in 1985. I have spent several hours reviewing this file and I am preparing a list of what documents I can determine with certainty have been deleted from the B-1 file before it was produced. I have not yet completed the review nor the list of missing documents.
- 2. The documents missing from the B-1 file fall into two general categories: pre- and post-June 1982. There are no B-1 or GO intelligence type documents or B-1 entries after June 1982. Even though the name B-1, or GO, or Guardian's Office, may have been discontinued in June 1982, the same intelligence activities continued, and in my case accelerated. Intelligence reports and operations since June 1982 have been entirely deleted from the "B-1" file. Among the pre-June 1982 materials, there are many documents referred to either in the "time track" or chronology, or in the other documents actually received which were not produced. The organization obviously had the missing documents when they prepared the time track or the referencing These are in some cases very important documents; for example a report of April 14, 1982 from Vaughn Young in which Young, who testified in my 1984 trial, claims I was having a homosexual relationship with Omar Garrison; or the February 6,

1982 report showing that Terri Gamboa, on staff at Author Services Incorporated, ordered the "suppressive person" declare on me be issued.

I declare under the penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct.
