With the exception of six documents which had been marked for identification but not admitted into evidence during the May-June 1984 trial of CSC's case against Armstrong, Ms. Hart returned to Mr. Peterson all of the documents and exhibits originally placed in the custody of the Clerk of the Court at the outset of the litigation.
- 3. On December 17, 1986, I accompanied CSC counsel Timothy Bowles to the Los Angeles Superior Court where we met with Mr. Fred Roeder, the supervisor over the Superior Court archives files. Mr. Roeder informed us that he had been told by his counterpart at the Court of Appeal that the trial exhibits furnished to the Court of Appeal for the then pending appeal were no longer needed, and that those exhibits had been returned to the Superior Court by the Court of Appeal. Mr. Roeder thereupon returned to Mr. Bowles all of the exhibits which had been returned to him by the Court of Appeal along with certified copies of the trial court exhibits for which the originals had been returned the previous day.
