Dufficy; that Judge Dufficy 4 will be out of town on Friday, March 6, and intends instead to issue 5 a tentative ruling on plaintiff's motion on Thursday, March 5, with 6 oral argument to follow, if it is requested by either party, on or 7 following March 16, 1992. Plaintiff requests that in the event that 8 the Court, after a full review of the moving and opposing papers 9 concerning the preliminary injunction, finds tentatively that an 10 injunction should issue, that the Court issue a Temporary 11 Restraining Order identical to the Preliminary Injunction for the 12 time period from March 5, 1992 until the ultimate resolution of 13 plaintiff's motion. 14
