DECLARATION OF GERALD ARMSTRONG


I, Gerald Armstrong, declare:

1. I am a defendant in the case of Church of Scientology International v. Gerald Armstrong, Michael Walton and The Gerald Armstrong Corporation, Marin Superior Court case no. 157680.

2. Upon reading Scientology's memorandum in support of its demurrer to my second amended cross-complaint in this case, received in attorney Ford Greene's office on May 23, 1994, I learned for the first time that a lis pendens relating to the home of co-defendant Michael Walton and Solina Walton had been filed in this case by plaintiff Scientology organization after the expungement of an earlier lis pendens had been ordered by the Court. I then obtained a copy of the second lis pendens, filed November 29, 1993, from the Court's file. Although I am shown on the proof of service of said document as having been served with two copies of said document on November, 29, 1993, at 715 Sir Francis Drake Boulevard, San Anselmo, California, I was not so served. I had never seen this document until I obtained it from the Court file and had not known that it existed until I received Scientology's opposition.

I declare under the penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct.

DECLARATION OF MICHAEL WALTON


I, Michael Walton, declare:
