B] although the accumulated interest remained in Los Angeles. This Court having issued a permanent injunction, there is no longer any need for the deposit.

7 Accordingly, pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 8 995.360(a), plaintiff Church of Scientology International and 9 defendant Gerald Armstrong stipulate that the deposit of \$70,000 10 made by the plaintiff in this action upon the issuance of a 11 preliminary injunction may be withdrawn from the Court and 12 returned to the plaintiff, together with interest thereon. The issues on to any of B 13 to appeal from the parties also agree that Armstrong's right order of permanent injunction in this action is 14 not affected by 15 this stipulation.
