The houses shown in this book are constructed in the most approved manner, and if our plans and specifications are strictly adhered to we can grarantee utmost satisfaction. Ahmost all the houses herein are sheathed, papered and sided, and have double floors. The interiors are of slash grained Washington fir, stained to suit owner's taste, and giving the richest color tones of any wood used for building purposes. The exteriors are, for the most part, of Washington Red Cedar, including shingles. Incorporated in the cost of the houses is all painting. staining, plombing, electric wiring and gas fitting. In some cases hot air furnaces or Ideal IIot Water Heaters are included.

Xearly all these honses were built by contract and the contractor's profits may be saved if the work is done by the owner.

Over the living room there is an open well looking into the chambers and bath room.
